Brokenness

In a world where vulnerability is talked down upon and having a big ego is boasted about, what could it possibly look like being broken before the Lord? In the month of November we dived into brokenness,

“Whomsoever, the Lord must use effectively MUST be broken” - Pastor Max

Here are some key takeaways from our November teachings:

- **Brokenness: to strip away your own desires and take up God's own (e.g. Abraham)**
- **God cannot journey with someone unwilling to change**
- **Refinement happens in prayer piety.**
- **God is impressed with those that stumble and run to Him (Psalm 37:23-24)**
- **‘Submit to God. Resist the devil. The devil will flee from you.’ (James 4:7)**

Making the last stride count

“Watch therefore, for you do not know what hour your Lord is coming.” Matthew 24:42

If every minute of the day you knew that God was watching you this year, what would you have done differently? We have 31 days of December and then we're on to 2026. Here's how we're planning to finish 2025 correctly:

1. 20 days of fasting to kick off December (details found on Whatsapp)
2. Prayer
3. Finish that Bible plan
4. Look out for signs and tokens for the year ahead (Jeremiah 29:11)
5. Plan out your year ahead with the Lord and set accountability partners for those plans (Psalms 90:17)

How to be an effective Christian daily

This month work on swapping out your screen time for:



Time in the Word

Set your heart on studying the scriptures whether that is via Bible plans, studying a character in the Bible or a book etc.



3 Hours prayer daily

Aim to be at morning prayer at 5.45am and give yourself time in God's presence. The teachings sink in more when you are a person of prayer. Maintain a life of prayer outside church!
