

Winona Sportsmen's Club News-n-Due Letter 2020

Another year in the books at one of the best clubs in the area. We hope that everyone was able to use their memberships as they had intended and enjoyed the year.

have added a Sr. Lifetime

Membership that was requested by many of our members and is at a ten times annual membership rate just like our regular membership. We are also making some price increases in multiple areas. The first one is with our current memberships.

Membership pricing is changing to the following:

This is being driven by multiple increases that the club saw in 2019, including a major increase for Insurance. With every new offering to our members comes a need to insure those offerings and our insurance increased by 50%. This includes, but is not limited to, the new Skeet field, houses and throwers as well as the new 100/200/300 yard rifle ranges and the overhead cover that was created for the shooters. We are not excited about any of these increases, but know that without increasing memberships, we will not be able to continue to grow

the club at the rate we need to. Please consider this your dues notice. We prefer you pay your dues in person at Mainstream or at the Club during open hours. As many of you know we have a new gate card system that was put in place for 2019. With the membership renewals, you will not receive a new gate card. Your current card will be deactivated on February 1st if you have not renewed your membership and will be reactivated upon renewal. This means you should keep your card. If for any reason we have to reissue a card to you, you will have to pay a \$10 fee for the card. Many of you have still not picked up your membership card for 2019 and they are at the club waiting to be picked up. The clubhouse is open every Saturday 10am-2pm year-round and Sunday 10am-2pm April until October. If you prefer to mail your renewal in, you may also print out an application from our website.
