INDICTMENT

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

On or about September 22, 2015, in the District of Wyoming and within the 48 conterminous states, the Defendant, **KELLY J. GROVE**, a person subject to the jurisdiction of the United States, did knowingly take a grizzly bear, a species then listed as threatened by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 1533 of the Endangered Species Act.
