On or about September 22, 2015, in the District of Wyoming and within the 48 conterminous states, the Defendant, **MATTHEW JOHN BROOKS**, a person subject to the jurisdiction of the United States, did knowingly take a grizzly bear, a species then listed as threatened by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 1533 of the Endangered Species Act.

In violation of 16 U.S.C. §§ 1538(a)(1)(G) & 1540(b)(1) and 50 C.F.R. §§ 17.40(b)(1)(i) & (2) (June 16, 2015).
