Makes one Bee

You will need:

YARN

#6 Super Bulky

Yellow

Black

White

HOOK

7-9mm

ABBREVIATIONS

ch – chain

sts – stitches

sc – single crochet

sc2tog – single crochet 2

together (decreasing)

Hdc – half double crochet

Dc – double crochet

Tr – treble crochet

slst – slip stitch

FO – Fasten Off

... – Repeat steps

(...) – make all in one space

Making the head *Using Black*

Magic Ring: 5 Hdc into the ring, pull to tighten circle, slst to close

Round 1: 2Hdc into each, slst to beginning
– end circle with 10 stitches

Round 2: ch2, *Hdc, 2Hdc*, repeat 4 more times, slst into top of 2-chain - do not fasten off

For Antennas *Keep using black*

{ch5, Hdc in 2nd chain from hook, slst in each chain}, sc, {ch 5, Hdc in 2nd chain from hook, slst in each chain}, sc, slst in next 2 – do not fasten off

For Body *Keep using Black*

ch1, Hdc into same spot, 2Hdc in next 3, ch2 -turn Hdc, 2Hdc, Hdc in next 3, 2Hdc in next 2; FO

*Turn work so yarn tail is on the right side of work
- Attach Yellow where black ends*

ch2, Hdc in same chain, Hdc, Dc in next 7, 2Hdc, ch2, turn - Dc in next 5, 2Dc, Dc in next 4, 2Dc; FO

*Turn work so yarn tail is on the right side of work
- Attach Black where yellow ends*

ch1, sc across (13), ch1, turn - sc each across; FO

*Turn work so yarn tail is on the right side of work
- Attach Yellow where black ends*

ch1, sc2tog twice, sc in next 7, sc2tog, ch2, turn – Dc in each across, ch1, turn – sc2tog twice, *sc, sc2tog* repeat once more, ch1, turn – sc, Hdc, (Dc, Tr), (Tr, Dc), Hdc, sc; FO

For Tail

*Turn work so yarn tail is on the right side of work
- Attach Black where yellow ends*

sc, Hdc in next 2, 3Hdc, Hdc in next 2, sc, ch1 -
turn skip1, sc in next 3, 3sc, sc in next 3, slst; FO

ABBREVIATIONS

ch – chain

sts – stitches

sc – single crochet

sc2tog – single crochet 2
together (decreasing)

Hdc – half double crochet

dTr – double treble crochet

slst – slip stitch

FO – Fasten Off

... – Repeat steps

(...) – make all in one space

Leave the ends to help fasten to the fence 😊

For Wings *Attach White at the edge and top of
bee about at the first yellow/black stripe*

**(ch4, Tr, dTr), (2dTr, Tr), ch2 – turn; Dc,
2Dc in next 3, Hdc in top of 4-chain*;* FO

*Attach white to position second wing behind first
wing; Repeat **;* FO

Finish

Bring your BEE to the chain link fence beside the
Gallagher Centre once installation begins and add
it to the chain or drop it off at the Yorkton Public
Library anytime between now and the start of
Culture Days (during their open hours) and we will
hang it for you!

You may retrieve your work after October 24th,
2021. All work will be removed on October 31th,
2021, any remaining work will become property of
the Yorkton Yarn Bomber Collective for future use.
