



# 5 Point Flower

*Makes one flower*

## **Centre of Flower** *Using MC colour*

Magic Ring: 8Dc into ring, pull to tighten, slst to close  
Round 1: 2Hdc into each, slst to join; FO  
– end circle with 16 stitches

## **Making Petal Base** *Attach EC*

Round 2: \*2Dc, Dc\* repeat between \*\* until last 2 stitches, 2Dc in each, slst into 1<sup>st</sup> Dc  
– end circle with 25 stitches

Each petal base involves:

\*ch4, Dc in the 3<sup>rd</sup> chain from hook, Tr in the last, slst into 3<sup>rd</sup> stitch on circle, slst in next 2\* - repeat between \*\* until you go all the way around circle – you will have 5 petal bases

## **Making Petal** *Keep using EC*

*Note – there should be 5 ‘spaces’ on each petal base*

\*2Dc in each space – this will be 10 Dc stitches worked; slst in next 3 on circle\*

Repeat between \*\* for each petal base until the last petal; FO

## **Finish**

Bring your FLOWER to the chain link fence beside the Gallagher Centre once installation begins and add it to the chain or drop it off at the Yorkton Public Library anytime between now and the start of Culture Days (during their open hours) and we will hang it for you!

You may retrieve your work after October 24<sup>th</sup>, 2021. All work will be removed on October 31<sup>th</sup>, 2021, any remaining work will become property of the Yorkton Yarn Bomber Collective for future use.

## You will need:

### **YARN**

#### **#6 Super Bulky**

Use as many colours as you would like. For this pattern we used two, one for the centre or middle (MC) and one for the edging (EC).

### **HOOK**

7-9mm

### **ABBREVIATIONS**

ch - chain

Hdc – half double crochet

Dc – double crochet

Tr – treble crochet

slst – slip stitch

FO – Fasten Off

\*...\* – Repeat steps
