ABBREVIATIONS

ch - chain sc – single crochet Hdc – half double crochet Dc – double crochet Tr – treble crochet slst – slip stitch (...) – make all in one space FO- Fasten Off *...* – Repeat steps

Makes one Ladybug

Making Centre

Using Black

Ch16, starting at 2nd chain from hook, sc into next 8, Hdc in next 2, Dc in next 3, Tr in next 2, ch1 – turn slst along the other side.

To Form Head Keep using black

(5Dc, Hdc) in end, ch2, turn – Dc in 1st, then 2Dc in next 5, ch1, turn - sc, 2sc, sc, 2sc, *{ch5, slst in 2nd chain from hook and each chain}*, sc, 2sc, sc, repeat **, 2sc, sc, 2sc, sc; FO

For Body Attach Red to Body in 14th chain from head Ch2, **Dc in next 13, slst at base of head through back loop, ch2, turn - Dc in the next 10, Hdc, sc, slst into last chain, ch1, turn – skip1, sc, Hdc in next 2, Dc in next 2, Tr in next 2, Dc in next 2, Hdc in next 2, sc, slst to corner through back loop; FO** Turn work over, attach yarn in 14th chain from head Ch2; repeat **to**

For Dots Using Black

Join by bringing yarn up from the back to front through the holes, repeating this motion to make 'dots', fill in the dot with a few more slip stitches. *Optional: glue felt circles or sewing on buttons*

Finish

Bring your LADY BUG to the chain link fence beside the Gallagher Centre once installation begins and add it to the chain or drop it off at the Yorkton Public Library anytime between now and the start of Culture Days (during their open hours) and we will hang it for you!

You may retrieve your work after October 24th, 2021. All work will be removed on October 31th, 2021, any remaining work will become property of the Yorkton Yarn Bomber Collective for future use.
