

You will need:

YARN

#6 Super Bulky
Use as many colours as you
would like. For this pattern we
used two, one for the centre or
middle (MC) and one for the
edging (EC).

HOOK

7-9mm

ABBREVIATIONS

ch - chain

sc – single crochet

Dc – double crochet

Tr – treble crochet

slst – slip stitch

FO – Fasten Off

... – Repeat steps

Large 7 Point Flower

Makes one flower

Centre of Flower *Using MC colour (blue)*

Magic Ring: Dc 12 times into ring, pull to tighten circle, slst to close

Round 1: *2Dc, Dc* until end, slst to join –circle should have 18 stitches; FO

Making Petal Base Attach EC (purple)

Round 2: 2Hdc, *2Hdc, Hdc* repeat ** until last stitch, 2Hdc, slst to join— end with 28 stitches
Round 3: *Dc, Dc, 2Dc* repeat ** until last 6 stitches
Dc in each, slst to join— end with 35 stitches
Each petal base involves:

ch5, Dc in the 3rd chain from hook, Tr in next 2, slst into 3rd stitch on circle from chain, slst in next 2 - repeat 6 more times

Making Petal *Keep using MC*

Note – there should be 7 'spaces' to use on the petal base *2Dc in each space - this will be 14 Dc stitches worked, slst in next 3 stitches on circle*
Repeat for each petal base, slst at the end; FO

Finish

Bring your FLOWER to the chain link fence beside the Gallagher Centre once installation begins and add it to the chain or drop it off at the Yorkton Public Library anytime between now and the start of Culture Days (during their open hours) and we will hang it for you!

You may retrieve your work after October 24th, 2021. All work will be removed on October 31th, 2021, any remaining work will become property of the Yorkton Yarn Bomber Collective for future use.
