Makes one leaf

You will need:

YARN

#6 Super Bulky
A shade of green

HOOK

7-9mm

ABBREVIATIONS

- ch - chain
- sc – single crochet
- Dc – double crochet
- Hdc – half double crochet
- Tr – treble crochet
- hTr – half treble crochet
- dTr – double treble crochet
- slst – slip stitch
- (...) – make all in one space
- FO – Fasten Off
- *...* - repeat steps
between*

Foundation Chain

ch11, starting in 2nd chain from hook slst into each chain, ch1 in end, working on other side, slst into each chain, sc in the end- you should have 10 stitches on each side

Round 1

ch2, *working in the back loop only* – Dc in next 2, Tr in next 2, dTr, Tr in next 3, Dc, Hdc, in the end space work (Hdc, Tr, ch1, sc); *working on other side and in the back loop only* – sc, Hdc, Dc, Tr in next 2, dTr, Tr, Dc in next 2, Hdc, slst in the 2-chain from the beginning; for small leaf fasten off; or continue to make larger

Round 2

ch2, Dc in next 2, 2Dc, 2Tr, dTr, 2Tr, 2Dc, Dc in next 4; (2Dc, Tr, ch1, sc) in the end, sc, Hdc in next 2, Dc, Hdc, 2Hdc in next 2, Dc in next 5, slst into the 2 chain from the start of round; FO

Finish

Bring your LEAF to the chain link fence beside the Gallagher Centre once installation begins and add it to the chain or drop it off at the Yorkton Public Library anytime between now and the start of Culture Days (during their open hours) and we will hang it for you!

You may retrieve your work after October 24th, 2021. All work will be removed on October 31th, 2021, any remaining work will become property of the Yorkton Yarn Bomber Collective for future use.
