



Simple Butterfly

Makes one Butterfly

Making the Wings

Magic Ring: ch2, 5Hdc into the ring, pull to tighten circle, slst to close – end circle with 6 Stitches

Round 1: (2Hdc, ch3, 2Hdc), slst, (2Hdc, ch1, 2Hdc), (2Hdc, ch1, 2Hdc), slst, (2Hdc, ch3, 2Hdc), slst to circle

Round 2: sc, (3Dc, 2Tr, dTr, 2Tr, Dc, Hdc in 3-chain space), sc in next 3, (5Dc in next 1-chain space), skip1, slst, skip1, (5Dc in next 1-chain space), sc in next 3, (Hdc, Dc, 2Tr, dTr, 2Tr, 3Dc in the last 3-chain space), sc, slst

For Antennas

ch5, Hdc in 2nd chain from hook, slst in each of remaining chains, slst in same space as start
repeat ** for second antenna; FO

Finish

Bring your BUTTERFLY to the chain link fence beside the Gallagher Centre once installation begins and add it to the chain or drop it off at the Yorkton Public Library anytime between now and the start of Culture Days (during their open hours) and we will hang it for you!

You may retrieve your work after October 24th, 2021. All work will be removed on October 31th, 2021, any remaining work will become property of the Yorkton Yarn Bomber Collective for future use.

Colour of your choice

HOOK

7-9mm

ABBREVIATIONS

ch - chain

sc – single crochet

Hdc – half double crochet

Dc – double crochet

Tr – treble crochet

dTr – double treble crochet

slst – slip stitch

(...) – make all in one space

FO – Fasten Off

... – Repeat steps
