OPERATION OF ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES AND GO-PEDS

In our continuing effort to ensure the safety of all citizens of Seminole County and with the increased amount of traffic on public and private roadways, your local deputies would like to address an important safety concern.

Some confusion exists on the legal operation of all-terrain vehicles. These vehicles most often include three or four wheelers, dirt bikes, go carts, and go-peds.

The operation of any of the above mentioned all-terrain vehicles on a public roadway, a private roadway accessible by the public, or upon a sidewalk is illegal. Should you do so, you are subject to being issued **traffic citations**, and **possibly arrest**.

These all-terrain vehicles are also called "off-road vehicles" which should remind you they are to be driven off of the road, not on the road.
