MOTION TO STRIKE JANUARY 21, 2026 HEARING, TO STAY PROCEEDINGS, TO PRESERVE AND CORRECT THE DOCKET, TO VACATE THE NOVEMBER 4, 2025 RULING, AND NOTICE OF PENDING SUPREME COURT WRITS

Plaintiff, appearing *pro se*, respectfully moves this Court for an Order (1) striking the hearing *currently* scheduled for January 21, 2026, (2) staying all further proceedings pending resolution of SC Supreme Court Case No. 2025-002290, and (3) preserving, correcting, and "freezing" the docket *to* protect the integrity of the record.

I. GROUNDS FOR MOTION

1. Vacated prior pleadings and resulting default: The *only* purported responsive pleadings filed for Defendants were vacated by this Court. Defendants remain in a state of Total Legal Default.
2. Lack of **standing** and oppressive **scheduling**: Parties in default lack standing to prosecute the **fifty-seven** (S7) motions "stacked" for January 21, 2026. This mass-scheduling against a medically fragile *pro se* litigant is inherently oppressive.
3. Pattern of backdating and **Rule 79 violations**: The Clerk's Office has created approximately 500 "blank" docket entry positions, facilitating retroactive insertion and backdating of filings to "cure" default status.

SUPPLEMENTAL MOTION TO **COMPEL** PHYSICAL STAMPING OF FILINGS
AND TO PRESERVE THE INTEGRITY OF THE DECEMBER 31, 2025
RECORD

Plaintiff, appearing *pro se*, hereby moves this Court for an Order compelling the *Clerk* of Court to perform the mandatory ministerial duty of physically stamping the original Motion filed on December 31, 2025:

1. THE "PARTIAL STAMP" SABOTAGE

- On **December 31**, 2025, Plaintiff presented a Motion for filing.
- The *Clerk of Court* (DawnPappas / Melissa *McCutchenj*) applied a "FILED" *stamp* only to the SCCA Cover Sheet, but intentionally omitted the stamp from the **Motion** itself.
- This "Partial Stamping" is a recognized tactic used to create a "Ghost Filing"—where the cover sheet exists on the docket, but the substantive Motion can be swapped, altered, or deleted from the digital system.

2. RELATION TO DIGITAL SPOLIATION

- This failure to stamp the Motion occurred while the docket contained over 500 blank **entries**.
- Plaintiff alleges this is a deliberate attempt to facilitate "Stage 3 Scrubbing," where the Clerk can claim the SCCA-233 was filed "empty" or that the Motion was never received, despite it being physically delivered.

2. DEMAND FOR **VERIFICATION**

- Plaintiff demands that the Clerk of Court immediately apply the December 31, 2025 date-stamp to the original Motion to match the SCCA form.
- Plaintiff demands that this document be "Locked" in the record to prevent it from being moved into the "blank entries" utilized to re-author the case history.

3. CONCLUSION

- The Clerk's office does not have the discretion to choose which parts of a filing to stamp. The failure to stamp the Motion while stamping the cover sheet is evidence of **Administrative Bad Faith**.

2.Parallel dockets: The *maintenance* of dual dockets [*Common Pleas* vs. Master-in-Equity) creates a fragmented and manipulated record, depriving Plaintiff of meaningful appellate review.

3. Unauthorized Filings: Eugene LeRoy Nettles III (October 7th, 2025) and Parker Brown (June 25,2025) made filings prior to being recognized as attorneys of record. These are legal nullities.

4. Fraudulent "Shadow Filings" and Mail Tracking: Counsel mailed documents to Plaintiff that were never recorded with the Clerk. Plaintiff incorporates by reference the exhibits in Supplemental Addendum , July 7th, 2025, July 3rd, 2025, November 6th,2025 which contain USPS tracking numbers originating from the Nettles firm, proving Plaintiff responded to every "shadow filing."

5. Proof of Timely Response: The tracking numbers prove Plaintiff was consistently ahead of the Defense in procedural diligence. The Defense's claim of "non-response" is a fraud upon the Court.

6. Administrative Conflict: The notices were processed by staff with a professional nexus to Judge Michael G. Nettles, creating a structural conflict of interest.

7. Motion to Vacate November 4, 2025 Ruling: This hearing was held while Plaintiff was recovering from a stroke and while the unrepresented no-defendant, Gloria Brown, was absent. This violates Due Process.

8. Pending Writ: The SC Supreme Court is currently reviewing these jurisdictional and procedural irregularities under **a Writ of Mandamus** and **Writ of Prohibition**.

II. RELIEF REQUESTED

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff respectfully *requests an* Order:

1. STRIKING the January 21, 2026 hearing;
2. STAYING all further proceedings pending resolution of SC Supreme Court Case No. 2025-002290;
3. FREEZING the docket to prevent additional backdated filings;
- 4. UNIFYING** the record into a single chronological docket;
5. VACATING any orders resulting from the November 4, 2025 hearing;
- 6. STRIKING** all "shadow filings" that lack an official docket entry and SCCA-233;
7. TAKING **JUDICIAL** NOTICE of Supplemental Addendum July 14th, 2025, July 3rd, 2025,and November 6th, 2025 numbers contained therein.

Refuting Claims of Non-Response through Self-Authenticating Receipts

The following exhibits, already on file with this Court, contain physical receipts and tracking numbers from the United States Postal Service (USPS) that match the correspondence sent by the Nettles firm. This evidence proves the Plaintiff provided timely responses to all "shadow filings" and correspondence.

- 1. Supplemental Addendum 714 (Filed July 14, 2025):** This filing contains the original envelopes and USPS Tracking Numbers originating from Defense Counsel. This evidence directly matches the Plaintiff's recorded **Answer and Counterclaim**, proving that a timely response was made to the unauthorized "Shadow Filings" received.

The tracking numbers contained within these exhibits are **self-authenticating**. 1. Plaintiff reaffirms that the operative "Omnibus Complaint", filed and amended pursuant to Rule 15, SCRCP, remains the active pleading in this matter, and that Defendants *failed* to respond within the required timeframe under Rule 12.
2. Plaintiff hereby clarifies that the full amount of relief sought in this action totals "Three Million Nine Hundred Seventy-Eight Thousand Dollars (\$3,978,000)". 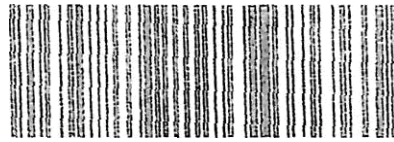

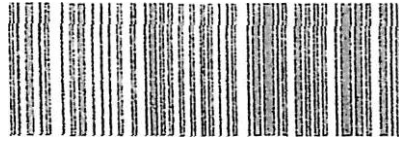

4. Plaintiff received two letters by certified mail on June 25, 2025: one from the Clerk of Court (Exhibit MM-1) and one from opposing counsel, Attorney *Joseph* Heath (Exhibit MM-2). Both letters contained identical claims that a hearing had occurred on June 2, 2025, and both were mailed *only* after Plaintiff had already filed multiple objections regarding docket manipulation and due process violations.

5. The certified mail receipt (Exhibit MM-3), USPS Form 3849 (Exhibit MM-4), and postmarked envelopes from both the Clerk and Attorney Heath (Exhibit MM-5) prove that neither document was delivered or *even* attempted until weeks after the supposed hearing.

6. These actions collectively constitute fraud upon the court by introducing a fabricated judicial event into the record and depriving the Plaintiff of notice and an opportunity to be heard. A court order based on a falsehood is void ab initio and must be *stricken*.

7. Pursuant to Rule 60(b)(4), SCRPC, a judgment or order entered without due process is void and subject to mandatory vacatur.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff respectfully requests that this Court:

- STRIKE the Order of Reference filed June 16, 2025;
- Restore full jurisdiction to the Circuit Court;

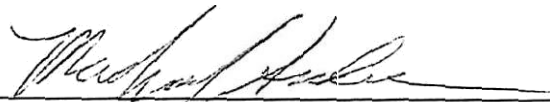

This matter is before the Court pursuant to a Motion for a Temporary Restraining Order and a Preliminary Injunction filed in the Court of Common Pleas for Florence County on May 12, 2025, and a Motion to Stay Eviction and a Motion to Cancel Hearing in Magistrate Court filed in the Court of Common Pleas for Florence County on May 16, 2025.

A hearing on the motions was held on June 2, 2025, attended by Defendant, William Eaddy, accompanied by his attorney, Joseph Cantey Heath, and Defendant, Gloria Brown, who appeared *pro se*. The Plaintiff did not appear at the hearing. Upon consideration of the argument for Defendant, William Eaddy, and a review of the pleadings on file with the court, the court denies Plaintiff's Motions and finds this case should be referred to the Florence County Master-in-equity pursuant to Rule 53 of the *South Carolina Rule of Civil Procedure*.

Rule 53(b), SCRPC, provides that "in an action where the parties consent, in a default case, or an action for foreclosure, some or all of the causes of action in a case may be referred to a master or special referee by order of a circuit judge or the clerk of court. In all other actions, the circuit court may, upon application of any party or upon its own motion, direct a reference of some or all of the causes of action in a case."

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that this case is referred to W. Haigh Porter, the Florence County Master-in-Equity, to make findings of fact and conclusions of law; dispose of any and all issues and direct entry of final judgment in this action under Rule 53, SCRPC. An appeal from the final judgment entered by the Master-in-Equity shall be directed to the Court of Appeals as provided by the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.

AND IT IS SO ORDERED.
