Phoenix Sister Cities, Phoenix Chengdu and Taipei committees and the Phoenix Chinese Week Committee will celebrate Phoenix Chinese Week 2016 and the Chinese New Year 4714, "The Year of the Monkey" from Feb. 8 to 14, with cultural and educational events at a variety of Valley locations.



Non-city employees and city of Phoenix retirees may join COP-MEA. Dues are paid in full for the year at the time of joining then annually thereafter. Another option is monthly payroll deductions from a city of Phoenix employee family member.

#### Membership rules:

- ⇒ You must be a member to purchase tickets or participate in COPMEA functions
- ⇒ Tickets and event passes purchased by COPMEA members are for the sole use of the card holder
- ⇒ Tickets and event passes cannot be purchased for anyone outside of the COPMEA membership
