#### ASSOCIATE ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP

\$48.00 single annual membership dues \$96.00 family annual membership dues Non-city employees and city of Phoenix retirees may join COPMEA. Dues are paid in full for the year at the time of joining then annually thereafter.

#### Membership rules:

- ⇒ You must be a member to purchase tickets or participate in COPMEA functions
