

The Florida Legislature has recognized that delays in permitting and inspections cause delays in property development and construction. To expedite property development and construction, the Legislature has enacted laws that allow property owners and contractors to hire private providers to perform building code inspection services (including plan review and inspections). Under Florida Law (fs553.791), a property owner or contractor can elect to utilize the services of a private provider in lieu of the local building official.

- INSPECTIONS- FBCCA mirrors the required inspections of each Jurisdiction we work in. We have to make notice (per statute) to the AHJ that we are doing such inspection prior to performing the inspection. The job site superintendent will need to send an email to us at inspection@fbcca.com including Master Permit Number, Lot #, Street Address, type of inspection required, and date/time needed. Your superintendent will receive a real time electronic copy of the "NOTICE to AHJ" when it is scheduled by us. Subsequently, a real time electronic inspection report will be sent from the job site to all listed recipients.
