



Monthly Meeting Minutes

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JANUARY 25, 2021

Our 8th Virtual Alumni meeting was called to order by President Jessica Martin at 7:00 pm.

Another discussion about not having a meeting each month but just a program. So a program one month and a meeting the next. We also discussed an outside meeting, or at least a get together (weather permitting)

Jessica said this boils down to what people are comfortable with. We will look at it again in a couple months. She also take all the suggestions to Sergeant Skundberg and Chef Stephens.

FEBRUARY 22, 2021

Our 9th Virtual Alumni meeting was called to order by President Jessica Martin at 7:00 PM .

Jessica began the meeting with several announcements. We all received our Surveys today in the mail. We are trying to get an idea from our members on things they would like to see moving forward. What are/can we do to remain active, LPCAAA? What are some of the things we used to do, that the Police Department has had to start doing?

Seargent Skundberg began by letting us know that he had great news!! He is hearing rumors that we may be able to return very soon, both LPCAAA and CSV. We are going to start ramping up the 1st of April! He has just recently started back to working full time. Police Department is down 7 officers and 1 to go April 1, 2021. They are doing back to back hiring. Everyone is expected back to work April 1, 2021 along with the City Center. The plan is to engage us at that time. WWW scheduled. Of course this could change. Planning on some retraining. Not sure how long. Ron Etter thinks we could retrain in a couple hours, Steve thinks a month, except for Will 2 months!! ;-). Safety for us with the unrest in the country has been a concern for the Department. Some circumstances will call for training for CSV members. Carli asked the question: how are the officers doing? Steve responded: Ok--- they are very busy and there is a lot of strain on them with the short staff. They go from issue to issue, even our Special Forces are out on Patrol. Littleton did not see very much of Black Lives Matter issues. Had a few marches but very peaceful. We lost some officers to retirement.

Our officers really like the 'Adopt a Cop' program that the LPCAAA has been doing. Steve has heard a lot of good comments about the cards they have received. Deb asked if the Police will be required to get COVID shots? The answer was no, shots are totally voluntary. The same with Volunteers, they cannot force anyone to get vaccinated. Maggie asked if when we start back up are there certain responsibilities and tasks that you want to give back to us? Steve, YES, scanning stuff...everything! Sean Carlson is working on body cams for officers. Needs to be in place in 2023. Boulder County has about the same size force that Littleton does, and so far has spent about a million dollars. For Littleton to implement Body Cams Steve has heard from 1 to 3 million. Some questions/discussion regarding old cases. Laurie asked about Academy, Steve said not this Spring but maybe next fall. Will asked, will the Police be able to tell us what shifts and where we will be the best help to them? Steve - Officers are new and haven't worked with us so will need to get to know us and build relationships. Tami asked if there was anything we can do now? Steve said everything we have done has been great!! He thanked all of us for hanging in there through all of this, and one last thing, if any of us have any thoughts questions etc just call Steve and he will be happy to chat with us.

Jessica Martin: we have two positions to fill, President Elect and Programs. Anyone interested please give Jessica a call.

Treasurer: Sue Otto, absent. Jess reported there were no changes

Secretary: Susan Schwab, nothing new to report. (I did get the minutes done and sent to the Board)

Media: Becky Woods, the new Web Site is ready she just needs some help from Jessica to get it online.

Membership: Judy Schnittker, no updates at this time. We have just sent out the Survey and will call those that have not returned theirs on 3/15/21

Volunteers: Tami Wasson, need our hours for 2020. When she knows who the new officers are she will send names out.
