Joining Team Jesus—Responding to the Offer On The Table

Self-guided and Group Leaders:

Decide how *you* would like to cover chapter six. I recommend having groups read chapter six on their own. Encourage the reader to seriously ponder the question, "*Have I ever made a genuine commitment to live my life for Jesus; to make Him the Lord over my life and live each day for Him—not myself?*"

Once your group has completed the chapter, challenge them to text, call, or email you if they have prayed a "post-game victory prayer" for the first time, *or* made a decision to recommit their life to Christ. Then celebrate this decision! Reiterate to the group that there is no such thing as a "magic prayer," and that salvation is a matter of the heart, not a matter of words.

If your group is small and the members have built a strong, trusting relationship with one another, you can opt to read this chapter together, talk about the recruitment process, and how it relates to basketball and the Christian life.

Any time a person places their faith in Jesus Christ, there needs to be a "next steps" plan in order for that person to grow in their faith. This is part of a process we call *discipleship*; a process of learning biblical principles that guide the believer towards righteous living, while deepening their knowledge and understanding of who God is.

Chapter 7 rounds out our timeout with: "*I've Made a Formal Commitment. Now What?*" These pages will detail five crucial steps to jumpstart one's journey of faith. But these steps aren't just for new believers, they are **lifelong disciplines** for **all** believers! Remember, the best athletes in the world cling tightly to the fundamentals—never forsaking them. Shouldn't it be the same for Christ-followers?
