- Have class members rotate reading through the bullet points on pages 10-12. Pause to discuss each potential "false god," as you feel led.
- Have someone read the quotes below, (found on page 13), then ask the question, "Do you believe you have placed Jesus above all your other pursuits? Explain.



- "I believe God places dreams and passions in our hearts that he wants us to pursue, but none of them are as important as the pursuit of Him."
- Placing him first in your life should be your daily goal, the main pursuit in the midst of all your other pursuits."

NOTE TO LEADER:

- The "Player Application" section on page 13 is critical. We want to allow the class members to ponder the question: "Have I ever made a <u>real</u> and personal decision to commit my life to Christ; to pursue Him above anything or anyone else?"
- Encourage the members to THINK about it, but they do not have to answer out loud unless they are prompted by the Spirit.
- Tell the members that you will stay after class if anyone wants to talk about this in more detail.
- If a student/member is "unsure" if they have ever *truly* made this decision, you may want to ask: "Do you believe your current life is proof that you made this decision in the past?"
- If their answer is "yes" you may want to reinforce scriptures such as John 5:24 and John 10:28.
- If the answer is "no," invite them to read the following scriptures: John 3:16, John 1:12, and Romans 10:9. Make sure you do not miss the opportunity to pray with them to receive Christ if they are ready to do so. (You may refer to the prayers on page 37-39 to guide you).
- Encourage them to keep attending the study! "The Fundamentals" of the Christian faith will follow, and may help clear up any questions they have regarding their faith walk.

- Are you guilty of playing "me ball" in your spiritual life?
- What areas in your life are taking priority over your relationship with Jesus?
- What can you start doing today to tear down false gods in your life and begin pursuing Jesus as your first passion?
