The 6th Jude Conference (God willing)

“Pillars of the Christian Faith” ~ Overall Theme & Sessions

“The Doctrines of God’s Word are truths that should inspire love and wonder in every Christian. They are foundational for the church, providing guardrails for a right view of the way of salvation, evangelism, earnest preaching of the Gospel as well as God-honouring worship. These pillars have been attacked throughout church history. But rightly understood, they bring glory to God and elevate our love for Christ, causing us to want to live holy lives in total dependence on Him.”

Keynote: The Sovereignty of God – *Pastor Darren Cadapen*

1. **Defining the Doctrines of Grace:** The emergence of the Doctrines of Grace were an affirmation of Biblical Theology; yet today they contrast sharply to a pseudo-Calvinism – *Pastor John Thackway*
2. **The Wonders of Redeeming Grace:** The timeless truths of Unconditional Election and Limited Atonement exalt the work of The Lord Jesus Christ and flow directly from the Covenant of Redemption – *Pastor Malcolm Watts*
3. **A Biblical Approach to Evangelism:** The fact that salvation is a work of God alone does not exclude human instrumentality. The clear Biblical warrant for Gospel preaching avoids both “Hyper-Calvinism & Decisionism” – *Pastor Jonathan Northern*
4. **Panel Session:** A Pastoral response to the commonly asked questions that frequently arise with the Doctrines of Grace
5. **Secure in Christ:** The believer’s sure and certain hope is built on the finished work of Christ and His unbreakable promises; it provides us with great comfort and security, yet we must avoid abusing our many spiritual privileges – *Pastor Oliver Wyncoll*

1. Pastor Cadapen was born to Mauritian parents, and has been the Pastor of East Dulwich Tabernacle, South London, since 2015. He previously worked for the TBS on the editorial team. He has spoken at Jude several times and is one of the organising committee members for Jude.
