



Overall points will be tabulated for May & September and awarded after the September show.

Supreme High Point Horse/Rider - High Point Ribbon, plus awards

All classes count toward points from all showbills (except the Fun Show) including walk/trot classes.

Supreme Walk/Trot High Point Horse/Rider - High Point Ribbon, plus awards

All classes not requiring the lope/canter count toward points from all showbills (except the Fun Show)

Anyone showing in ANY Canter Classes are not eligible for Walk/Trot High Point award

*** Currently the Speed Show does not offer Walk/Trot Classes - HOWEVER - if we get enough interest we will be happy to add W/T Barrels/Poles/Flags for 2025 - we just need feedback from our exhibitors!***

Rules:

- In order to qualify for a High Point award, the horse and rider combinations must compete at both the May and September horse shows in 3 separate showbills: Wes Morelock Memorial Western Show, Hunter/Jumper Show, Speed Show, English Pleasure Show, Dressage Show not including the Fun Show.
- IEF Board decisions are final.
- Awards are subject to change The more participation we have the more we can add!
- Points based on the individual horse/rider combination and cannot transfer to another horse or another rider.
- Anyone showing in any classes requiring the lope or canter are ineligible for the Supreme Walk/Trot Highpoint.
- The Supreme Walk/Trot High Point winner is ineligible to win both highpoint awards.
 - Should the situation arise that the Walk/Trot winner has accumulated more points than all other horse and rider combinations, we will look at the second highest overall point combinations to make the determination.
 - Should the second highest score also be eligible for the Walt/Trot HP, then the Supreme Walk/Trot
 award will be awarded to them and the Supreme High Point will be awarded to the Walk/Trot rider who
 outscored all horse and rider combinations.
 - Should the second highest score NOT be a Walt/Trot eligible horse/rider combination The Walt/Trot scorer will be awarded Supreme Walk/Trot High Point and the other pair will be awarded the Supreme High Point.
 - o <u>THIS IS ONLY IN THE EVENT THE WALK/TROT COMBINATION OUTSCORES EVERYONE!</u>
- Unsportsman like conduct will not be tolerated and eligibility can be revoked at IEFs discretion.

REMEMBER!

- The Western, English Pleasure and Hunter Jumper Shows all have halter/in-hand classes
- Walk/Trot classes are available on all applicable showbills except the Speed Show
- We have Classical AND Western Dressage
