"One Big Beautiful Bill" Will Make America More Secure and Prosperous

Dear Representative:

The House will soon vote on passage of the "One Big Beautiful Bill" that restores guardrails to prevent Medicaid fraud and verify eligibility; adopts work requirements for capable adults; prevents money laundering that subsidizes health insurance for illegal aliens; protects taxpayers from being forced to fund the Big Abortion industry; and prevents a massive tax increase on families and small businesses.

This bill honors the right of parents to guide the education and upbringing of their children in an educational setting of their choice. It also provides support for scholarships that assist families of modest means in educating their children.

America's students are underperforming by international standards and our own. Low-income Americans are particularly underserved by an education system that lacks freedom and competition.
