We've put together this short presentation to take you through the journey we've been on as a school under our current leadership team and Head Teacher Mick MingStones, appointed in September 2010.

The first Ofsted visit took place in 2011 within 4 months of Mick taking up appointment.

Overall Grading: Good. Leadership Grading: Good.

Ofsted commented that "The newlyappointed head teacher has a very clear vision for school improvement"

- The roles of talented leaders and managers at all levels are being developed further.

Within 3 years Ofsted visited again in 2013, at which point we were already making great strides towards the school we are today.

- Led by an energetic, resilient and committed head teacher, the deputy head, senior leaders and governing body provide outstanding leadership.
- The curriculum is outstanding and exciting approaches and themes help spark a love of learning amongst the pupils.
- A 'Life Skills' program, including first aid, positive thinking, and endurance through bike riding, focuses the pupils on wider achievement and personal development.



In 2018 we were visited again with Ofsted looking to see how the school culture had developed since their last assessment.

Overall Grading: Good.

Leadership: continues to be Outstanding

With the education landscape in the country changing Ofsted commented that "Determined and effective leadership has ensured that the school has adapted well to the higher expectations of the national curriculum."

- Parents were keen to praise the wide variety of experiences provided beyond the school site, such as residential trips, long-distance cycling events and bushcraft sessions, which they described as motivational and character-building.
- The senior leadership team, well supported by middle leaders in each phase of the school, is ambitious and committed to improving the quality of education.
- WDPS provides a rich and varied curriculum that makes a positive contribution to pupils' academic and personal development.
