France, Corsica is a beautifully diverse island with various fortress towns and simply stunning beaches, that are only accessible by 4x4 or boat. All nestled amongst diverse wildlife and a laidback Mediterranean lifestyle. As a young family ourselves we have created this family friendly adventure to balance the amount of driving with other activities that are sure to keep your little ones entertained.





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Our itinerary



Day 1 & 2 - Saturday & Sunday

The tour meets in Folkestone in preparation for our channel crossing using the Euro Tunnel. Using the tunnel allows us to enjoy a speedy crossing (only 35mins) and join straight onto the French motorways to continue our journey through France. Splitting the journey into two days allows for an overnight stop in France where there will be the option to join us for an evening meal and the chance to get to know the rest of the group. Before departing for the south coast of France, we will provide you with a continental breakfast at the hotel. Upon arriving at Tulon, (time permitting) there will some time to explore and have a meal before embarking on the ferry and settling down for the night ready to arrive in Corsica the following morning.

Day 3 - Monday

Upon disembarkation from the ferry we will ensure that everyone has the opportunity to acquire supplies and fuel before the adventure begins. From the port town of Bastia, we will make our way along a mountain road with stunning views back down onto the east coast. As we crest the peak of the mountain, the true diversity of the island can be seen as we look down onto the town of St Florent and the beautifully secluded beaches along the north of the island. Arriving in St Florent for the evening, there will be a chance to settle into your chalet and enjoy the onsite pool and local amenities.





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Day 4 - Tuesday

To break up the driving, we set aside the second day for you to explore the island and its many historical landmarks. We can advise on a variety of locations to visit based on your interests.



Day 5 - Wednesday

This day is exclusively a chance to experience one of the best beaches on the island so pack up your swimwear and a picnic and be prepared to be amazed. As we make the 2hour off tarmac journey down to the beach, you will be teased by glimpses of the crystal clear sea and white sandy beach we are heading for. After the journey to the beach, you will have ample time to enjoy the beach and for the children to burn off some excess energy in the sea before our return journey. During the evening there will be the opportunity to join us at a fantastic restaurant 10minutes from the end of the route.

Day 6 - Thursday

Being the penultimate day of our time on Corsica, we have chosen to give you two options. For those of you who would like to experience Canyoning or a Via Ferrata (both unforgettable experiences) this is the day to do that and we can put you in contact with a company that can arrange this for you. For those who are less inclined to partake in extreme sports, there is the opportunity to undertake a second beach drive to another secluded beach.





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Day 7 - Friday

As the last day in Corsica we will take a drive over a mountain road with a lunch stop at the top of the pass. With spectacular views over the town of Lille-Rouse you won't want to head down to the port town of Bastia for our return to mainland France.

Day 8 & 9 - Saturday & Sunday

After disembarking from the ferry we begin our journey back to the UK. Again breaking the journey into 2 days allows us to have an overnight stop in France with an optional group evening meal on the Saturday. The Sunday morning will start with a continental breakfast before heading to the Eurotunnel for a quick journey back to England before heading our own ways home.

Corsica Ferries

With an overnight crossing inclusive of an inside, en-suite cabin, you and your passengers can relax on board whilst we travel to the island of Corsica. Traveling overnight means that we don't lose additional days traveling to our destination. Departure from the Port of Toulon late in the evening allows you to enjoy an evening meal and exploration of the town before heading to the docks 1.5hrs before departure. Whilst on board, you can enjoy a meal, undertake some shopping in the boutiques or relax in one of the many public areas on board. Arrival in the port of Bastia in the morning means that we can drive straight off the ferry to local supermarkets for supplies before heading out onto the mountain roads to start our off tarmac journey.



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Camping - Village Kalliste, St Florent

Camping - Village Kalliste is a campsite offering semi-permanent chalet accommodation in the coastal town of St Florent. The site boasts a swimming pool, restaurant, bar and convenience store on site. As well as a wide variety of amenities on site the village of St Florent offers a wide range of cafes, bars shops and restaurants.

All chalets are equipped with a kitchenette, 2 bedrooms, a living area, separate bathroom and toilet and your own private terrace with table and chairs. The central location of Camping - Village Kalliste allows for easy access to the various off-tarmac routes throughout the week.



Off the Beaten Track 4x4 excursions

As part of your trip, Off the Beaten Track 4x4 will provide a guide service from the Eurotunnel departure terminal in Folkestone to Corsica. Whilst in Corsica, Off the Beaten Track 4x4 will provide a maximum of 4 off tarmac driving days throughout your holiday. All off-tarmac driving days will be subject to weather and track conditions due to health and safety reasons. These days will run from 9:30am till approximately 4pm and will encompass as much off-tarmac driving as possible.
