Our itinerary



Day 1 & 2 - Saturday & Sunday

The tour meets in Folkestone in preparation for our channel crossing using the Euro Tunnel. Using the tunnel allows us to enjoy a speedy crossing (only 35mins) and join straight onto the French motorways to continue our journey through France. Splitting the journey into two days allows for an overnight stop in France where there will be the option to join us for an evening meal and the chance to get to know the rest of the group. Before departing for Andorra, we will provide you with a continental breakfast at the hotel.

Day 3 - Monday

On your first full day in the beautiful Pyrenees, you will start the day with a breakfast at the hotel before heading into town to grab some lunch supplies for a picnic along the route. We will start the driving by heading out to Pic de Lori. On this route you will experience unrivalled views of the surrounding mountains and valleys as we travel along the service tracks used by the ski resorts throughout the winter.

Day 4 - Tuesday

Our second day in Andorra is set aside for you to explore either the fantastic city of Andorra la Vella and its fantastic spa Caldea or experience the thrill of the worlds longest nature slide or the worlds biggest sky trail at Naturlandia.



Day 5 - Wednesday

As we meet the halfway point of the trip, we take a journey along one of the most well used historic smugglers routes between Andorra and Spain. Throughout this day, you will experience traditional mountain passes and superb views down the various valleys. Not long after crossing the border into Spain, we drive through the remote town of Tor where, if open, we will stop for a drink at the local bar.

Day 6 - Thursday

During this penultimate day in Andorra we give you the option to enjoy the local tourist hotspots. Why not starting with the Roc del Quer view point that overlooks the valley before driving down to the bottom of the valley and finishing with the indoor markets just north of Canillo. Here you can assault your senses with traditionally cured meats and a fantastic selection of wines and spirits.

Day 7 - Friday

On our final day, we will journey along the Pic Negre route. During this day we will travel some of the highest drivable routes in the area up to approximately 8600ft above sea level. Again offering further spectacular panoramic views and our final picnic lunch.

Day 8 & 9 - Saturday & Sunday

We begin our journey back to the UK. Again breaking the journey into 2 days allows us to have an overnight stop in France with an optional group meal on the Saturday. The Sunday morning will start with a continental breakfast before heading to the Eurotunnel for a quick journey back to England before heading our own ways home.

As part of your trip, Off the Beaten Track 4x4 will provide a guide service from the Eurotunnel departure terminal in Folkestone to Andorra. Whilst in Andorra, Off the Beaten Track 4x4 will provide a maximum of 4 off tarmac driving days throughout your holiday. All off- tarmac driving days will be subject to weather and track conditions due to health and safety reasons. . These days will run from 9:30am till approximately 4pm and will encompass as much off-tarmac driving as possible.
