

- Primarily small farmers with less than 10 employees
- Collectively harvest > \$163M

45% clams, 55% oysters production growing 5-10% / yr oyster production doubled in 5 yrs

- Inventories depleted

2022 Legislative Priorities

- FDA / ISSC regulatory overreach on mooring fields.
- Shellfish Aquaculture Improvement Act Jones Act exemption
- Research Priorities
 - Shellfish Breeding (\$1.8M for USDA ARS)
 - Vibrio detection
 - HAB detection / mitigation
 - Guano prevention and management

Key Challenges

- Protected resources issues
 - Eelgrass, Red knots, sturgeon, turtles, right whales
- FDA/ISSC regulations on mooring fields
- User conflicts and law suits
- Lobbying efforts Jones Act etc.
