

2026 CODE OF CONDUCT FOR ALL PARENTS, SPECTATORS, COACHES, & BOARD MEMBERS

As a participant of the Fayetteville Midget Football, INC (FMFI) organization, I agree to abide by the Code of Conduct regardless of a signed form.

As a parent, coach or board member of the FMFI organization, it is my responsibility to help enforce the Code of Conduct for Athletes through our actions and the example that we set. Please read the following and sign this as your pledge to help better the athletes of our Football & Cheer programs when participating in all FMFI activities. Violation of the following will result in dismissal from the FMFI and further participation with FMFI will be up to the discretion of the board of directors. This is a zero-tolerance policy.

- The use of alcohol/tobacco is PROHIBITED on FMFI property. May smoke in vehicles, with windows closed.
- I will show respect for all athletes, coaches, and fans whether they are a member of the FMFI or a member of the opposing team regardless of race, sex, creed, & ability. I promise I will demonstrate a positive attitude towards officials, parents, coaches, and board members.
- I promise I will not use profanity. Profanity is prohibited.
- Physical or verbal abuse with anyone before, during or after any practice, game or event. As adults we need to provide positive examples.
- No intimidating language or actions shall be directed toward players, coaches, spectators, quests or anyone.
- No heckling of game officials, coaches, or players
- Abuse, damage or deface any property where we practice or play games including equipment & uniforms. I will clean up after myself/child(ren) after practice & games.
- I promise to cooperate with all coaches, assistant coaches, student coaches, and board members.
- Any parent or player having any complaints with a coach needs to take this to the head coach first. If not resolved, you will then go to the football or cheer rep. Last step if still not resolved in the board of directors.
- Absolutely no spectators shall be allowed inside the fence on game days.
- I will not involve myself in conduct that will be detrimental to the success of the FMFI and in the best interest of all the athletes and families.
