

Once Jesus took our sin, we were forgiven, but in our minds The Law of Sin & Death remains...

We keep sinning....

We envision God adding these sins to our Sin Ledger, and so we keep feeling a need to repent, as taught in 1 John 1:9.

We confess, receive forgiveness, but sin again...

"Oh boy... this was a BIG sin." "God is angry with me." "He's tired of me confessing this sin over and over...."

"Man, I'll never get past this desire to sin." "What's the use of praying!"

We see ourselves as sinners, separated from the LOVE of God.

The truth is that there is only 1 sin that keeps us from heaven — unbelief in Jesus.

The illustration shows that when our Sin is forgiven, The Law of Faith replaces The Law of Sin & Death ...

We keep sinning... but sin is never imputed onto our account.

There is no more sin ledger! No more need to grovel for forgiveness!

We find ourselves approaching God with confidence, saying, "God Thank You for LOVING ME soooo much!"

We look at the Law of Faith and ask God to teach us about faith.

We start searching through the book and see it is full of Promises to claim.

We see it is full of blessings for us to speak over ourselves and our families.

We start searching for Laws of the Kingdom. We find them in the teachings of Jesus.

Hey.... wait a minute! This is the same book as The Law of Sin & Death with a new Cover! How can that be?

We've found true Grace. Grace covers over a multitude of sin.

We find ourselves approaching God sin-free like Adam & Eve in the garden.



Wait you might say! I KNOW I still sin. I feel the effects of sin! True! We do sin, but sin is not imputed onto our account in God's Eyes. Sin DOES affect the power the enemy has over our lives.

We do have an enemy remember — Satan.

Satan is the Father of Lies — a deceiver. He comes to steal, kill and destroy.

Satan wants us to think God is keeping a Ledger of Our Sins. He wants us trying to please God with our actions because he can come at our failure points with fear, doubt, discouragement, condemnation and confusion.
