

EASTER MESSAGE 2019

"HE IS NOT HERE, BUT HE HAS BEEN RAISED" LUKE 24:6

With great joy we celebrate the resurrection of Our Lord Jesus Christ, the Savior of the world. Today the heart fills with joy to shout with one voice: Hallelujah, Hallelujah, Hallelujah! It is the triumph of life, which has been manifested.

Christians celebrate the culminating moment of the historical life of Jesus of Nazareth, the Son of God. It is the great manifestation of new life: The Passover of the Lord Jesus! He is in our own Galilee, in our own life and personal reality. Today He accompanies our family and our parish community of All Saints.

Let us cultivate the visible signs of the risen one in our life: the spirit; the forgiveness of enemies; solidarity and opportunities for those who have lost everything and those who live in the peripheries of our cities; the practice of decent work, with the sweat of one's forehead; the awakening of hopes in those who have been deprived of their freedom and the dreams of an honest and hard-working life; return respect and serenity to violent homes so that life and human dignity is defended at all times, that is, so that the flame of hope in our hearts is not extinguished.

Dear community, let us be resurrected with Christ, so that we can change the attitudes that separate us from him and from our brothers and sisters. We are a living, firm and united family; that follows only the Messiah and that lets himself be filled with his grace.

Now we need to be closer to each other. A stone that falls from a tower is something small from material life. Our faith is bigger than the building, and the love of authentic Christians can withstand the trials of this life. He takes our burdens and makes us courageous servants and faithful missionary disciples.

Happy Easter to all of you and may the risen Lord continue to bless your life, your projects and your families!
