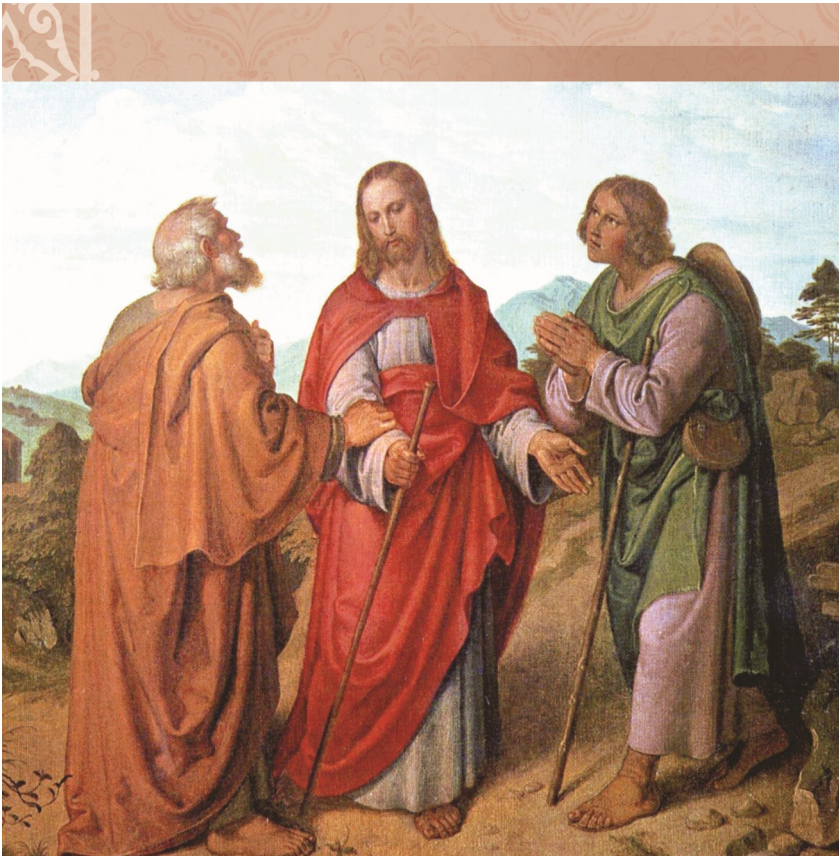

Por ley el Estado de Connecticut requiere mandatoriamente reportar cualquier incidente de abuso sexual que involucre a un menor o adulto vulnerable (un adulto con discapacidad intelectual). Incidentes de abuso sexual que incluyan adultos vulnerables de las edades de 60 años o más deben ser notificados a: *Department of Social Services 1-888-385-4225.*

Una vez que se haya recibido un informe por escrito si se ha recibido un incidente de abuso sexual de un menor de edad o un adulto vulnerable, se llevará a cabo una investigación en nombre de la Arquidiócesis de Hartford.
