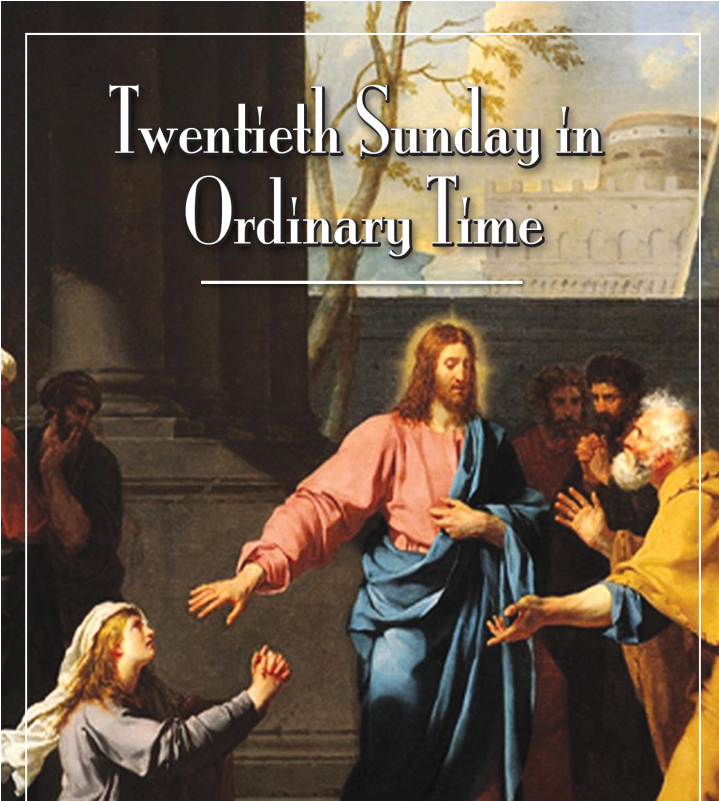

BECOME A VOCATION ADVOCATE!



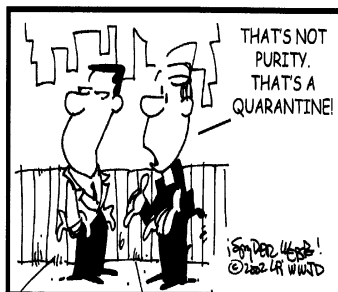
Join the St. John Vianney Vocation Prayer Society (SJVVPS), a new apostolate of the Office of Vocations of the Archdiocese of Hartford.
