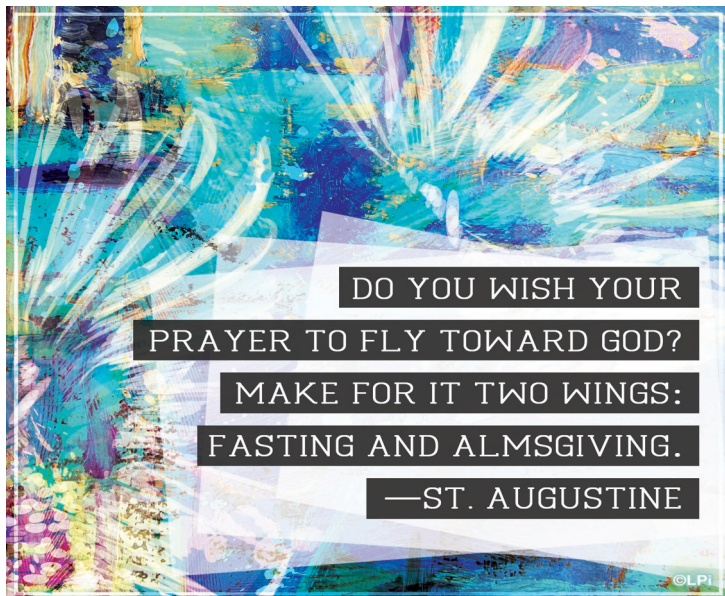

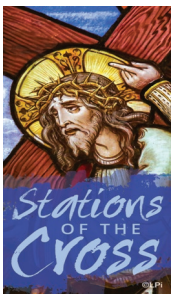

Este fin de semana marca el comienzo de la Campaña Anual del Arzobispo de 2018 en nuestra parroquia.

Si aún no lo ha hecho, pronto recibirá una carta del Arzobispo Blair solicitando su apoyo. Como católicos en la Arquidiócesis de Hartford tenemos un profundo impacto en nuestras comunidades locales no sólo en el ámbito espiritual, pero íntimamente conectados a él, el ámbito de los servicios sociales y de muchas organizaciones benéficas y servicios de extensión realizadas por, o con la ayuda de nuestra Iglesia .

En la edición más reciente de la Transcripción Católica, el Arzobispo Blair describió la Campaña Anual del Arzobispo como la recaudación de fondos de "pan y mantequilla" de la vida arquidiocesana. Es "pan y mantequilla" para la más amplia gama de actividades arquidiocesanas. Lo que se recoge para la apelación en un año determinado se gasta en ese año, para todo, desde la educación de nuestros seminaristas a las subvenciones concedidas a aproximadamente 250 organizaciones benéficas locales en toda la arquidiócesis que reciben apoyo financiero en el nombre del pueblo católico. Por segundo año consecutivo, en 2017, el Programa de Alcance Vicariato Anual del Arzobispo proporcionó más de \$ 1,000,000 a casi 250 organizaciones locales en los condados de Hartford, Litchfield y New Haven.

Organizaciones como la ARC, Coalición Hispano de Waterbury, Safe Haven y Ministerios Interfatih Waterbury aquí en nuestra propia ciudad recibió fondos del Programa de Extensión Vicaría de la apelación que marcan la diferencia en el servicio a nuestros vecinos.

Archbishop's Annual Appeal in our parish.***

If you haven't already, you will soon receive a letter from Archbishop Blair seeking your support. As Catholics in the Archdiocese of Hartford we have a profound impact on our local communities not only in the spiritual realm, but intimately connected to it, the realm of social services and many charities and outreach services performed by, or with help from, our Church.

In the most recent edition of the *Catholic Transcript*, Archbishop Blair described the Archbishop's Annual Appeal as the "bread and butter" fundraiser of archdiocesan life. It is "bread and butter" for the widest range of Archdiocesan activities. Whatever is collected for the Appeal in a given year is spent in that year, for everything from our seminarians' education to the grants made to approximately 250 local charities throughout the archdiocese that receive financial support in the name of the Catholic people. For the second year in a row, in 2017, the Archbishop's Annual Appeal Vicariate Outreach Program provided over \$1,000,000 to nearly 250 local organizations in Hartford, Litchfield and New Haven counties.

Organizations such as WARC, Hispanic Coalition of Greater Waterbury, Safe Haven and Waterbury Interfaith Ministries right here in our own town received funding from the Appeal's Vicariate Outreach Program that make a difference in serving our neighbors.
