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

Communion: Hand or Tongue?

Question: Why do some people receive Communion in the hand, while others have it put on the tongue? And is one better than the other?



Answer:

Prior to the liturgical reforms that accompanied the Second Vatican Council, it was the universal practice that Catholics would receive communion “on the tongue,” meaning that the one receiving would allow the priest distributing communion to place the consecrated host on their outstretched tongue. At this time, only the priest celebrant (and, on special occasions, priests assisting at the Mass) was allowed to receive the Precious Blood.

Since 1977 (with the approval of the Holy See) the bishops of the United States have officially approved two equally valid options for receiving Holy Communion in Masses celebrated according to the Ordinary Form of the Mass. As the bishops’ statement Norms for Holy Communion Under Both Kinds states:

The communicant may choose whether to receive the Body of Christ in the hand or on the tongue. When receiving in the hand, the communicant should be guided by the words of St. Cyril of Jerusalem: "When you approach, take care not to do so with your hand stretched out and your fingers open or apart, but rather place your left hand as a throne beneath your right, as befits one who is about to receive the King. Then receive him, taking care that nothing is lost" (no. 41).

As we noted, both ways of receiving communion are equally valid in the United States and it is important that we always keep the instructions of the bishops in mind as we reflect on which method we might prefer.

Comunión: ¿Mano o Lengua?

Pregunta: *¿Por qué algunas personas reciben la Comunión en la mano, mientras que otras la llevan en la lengua? ¿Y es uno mejor que el otro?*

Respuesta:

Antes de las reformas litúrgicas que acompañaron al Concilio Vaticano II, era una práctica universal que los católicos recibieran la comunión “en la lengua”, lo que significa que el que recibía permitiría al sacerdote que distribuía la comunión colocar la hostia consagrada en su lengua extendida. En este momento, solo el sacerdote celebrante (y, en ocasiones especiales, los sacerdotes que asistían a la Misa) podían recibir la Preciosa Sangre.

Desde 1977 (con la aprobación de la Santa Sede) los obispos de los Estados Unidos han aprobado oficialmente dos opciones igualmente válidas para recibir la Sagrada Comunión en las Misas celebradas de acuerdo con la Forma Ordinaria de la Misa. Como declaran los obispos en Normas para la Sagrada Comunión Bajo Ambos Tipos establecen:

El comulgante puede elegir si recibir el Cuerpo de Cristo en la mano o en la lengua. Al recibir en la mano, el comulgante debe guiararse por las palabras de San Cirilo de Jerusalén:

“Cuando se acerque, tenga cuidado de no hacerlo con la mano extendida y los dedos abiertos o separados, sino que coloque la mano izquierda como un trono debajo de tu derecha, como corresponde al que va a recibir al Rey, luego recíbelo, cuidando que nada se pierda”(n. 41).

Como notamos, ambas formas de recibir la comunión son igualmente válidas en los Estados Unidos y es importante que siempre tengamos en cuenta las instrucciones de los obispos al reflexionar sobre el método que podríamos preferir.
