The Apostles' Creed is the most ancient statement of the Christian faith still in regular use in the church today. Children are taught to memorize it, anyone who prays the Rosary says it at the beginning of each set of mysteries, and it remains one of the basic prayers in the Catholic canon. Yet where did it come from, what does it actually mean, and why are we called to believe it?

Dr. Brian Schmisek will be with us to engage what the church calls the twelve "articles" of the Apostles' Creed and to explore their meaning for a twenty-first century faith. We'll examine the scriptural roots of each article and punctuate that with questions designed to elicit and share faith. Our time together will connect scripture and the Creed to lived faith today.

All are invited and advance registration is required.

No charge. A free-will offering will be accepted. CBS students in their second, third and fourth years of study must register and are required to attend.
