Saint Thomas Aquinas | January 28

One of the most famous members of the Dominican Order, St. Thomas Aquinas (1225 – 1274) is well-known by many for his theological work, “The Summa Theologiae.” Born in Italy, his mother wanted him to become a Benedictine and had high hopes that he would eventually become abbot of Monte Cassino, where he spent much of his youth. To change his vocation, she had him kidnapped by his brothers on his way to Paris at the age of 19. He spent two years in their captivity. Despite this, nothing could shake him from his vocation to become a Dominican priest and he was eventually released. Once free, he went to Paris and then to Cologne, where he finished his studies with Albert the Great.

His greatest contribution to the Catholic Church is his writings. The unity, harmony, and continuity of faith and reason, of revealed and natural human knowledge, encompasses his writings. The Summa Theologiae, his last and, unfortunately, uncompleted work, deals with the whole of Catholic theology.

The patron saint of teachers, theologians and students, St. Thomas Aquinas died in 1274. His life and the impact he had on the whole Church, however, remains alive today.

NUESTRA SEÑORA DE LA ALTAGRACIA PATRONA DE REPÚBLICA DOMINICANA Y HAITÍ – FIESTA EL 21 DE ENERO

Nuestra Señora de la Altagracia es la Patrona de la isla Hispaniola, la isla que contiene las naciones de República Dominicana y Haití (algunas fuentes la mencionan como Protectora de la República Dominicana, en lugar de Patrona).

Historia de la imagen:

La imagen de la Virgen de la Altagracia ha sido venerada durante mucho tiempo en la región de Extremadura en España. Ha existido en la isla caribeña de Hispaniola desde principios de 1500, cuando dos hermanos españoles llevaron su imagen con ellos a su nuevo hogar en Higüey, ubicado en la esquina sureste de la isla.

La entusiasta devoción dominicana hacia ella, sin embargo, surge de una leyenda popular. Cuenta la historia que un anciano misterioso regaló la imagen, de forma casi milagrosa, a un padre para su hija que se la había pedido. La imagen luego desapareció de la casa y reapareció en un naranjo en flor. Esto ocurrió varias veces. Estos hechos se interpretaron en el sentido de que la imagen no pertenecía a una familia, sino a todos los dominicanos y debía exhibirse públicamente en la parroquia local. Un templo más grande fue dedicado en 1572 y la basílica actual en 1972 para exhibir la imagen de la “Alta Gracia” o Maternidad Divina.

Descripción:

La imagen, que engloba a la Sagrada Familia, es la natividad:

- Jesús en el pesebre (desnudo y pobre en su humanidad; dormido, pero resucitará)
- La Madre María con un rayo de luz “blanco como la nieve” (adornada con estrellas y coronada; velada como la novia virgen) con las manos en oración, claramente juega el papel central
- San José con una vela (al fondo ya que es sólo el padre adoptivo de Jesús; aureolado por su santidad; ofreciendo luz como servicio)
- La estrella de los Reyes Magos (Dios; luz; guía) y
- El fondo oscuro, como una cueva (el mundo en pecado).



Según el actual obispo de Higüey, la sagrada imagen es un ícono, un libro de símbolos y colores, rico en sabiduría, en el que los dominicos pueden leer las verdades de su fe.

OUR LADY OF HIGHEST GRACE - PATRONESS OF THE DOMINICAN REPUBLIC AND HAITI – FEAST DAY, JANUARY 21

Our Lady of Altas Gracias is the Patroness of the island of Hispaniola, the island containing the nations of Dominican Republic and Haiti (some sources list her as the Protector of the Dominican Republic, rather than Patroness).

History of the Image:

The image of the Virgin de la Altas Gracias “Virgin of Highest Grace” has long been venerated in the Extremadura region of Spain. It has existed on the Caribbean Island of Hispaniola since the early 1500's, when two Spanish brothers carried her image with them to their new home in Higuey, located in the southeastern corner of the island.

The enthusiastic Dominican devotion to her, however, grows out of a popular legend. The story goes that an old mysterious man gave the image, in an almost miraculous way, to a father for his daughter who had requested it. The image later disappeared from the house and reappeared in a blossoming orange tree. This occurred several times. These events were interpreted to mean that the image did not belong to one family, but to all Dominicans and should be displayed publicly in the local parish. A larger temple was dedicated in 1572 and the current Basilica in 1972 to display the image of the “Highest Grace” or Divine Maternity.



Description:

The image, encompassing the Holy Family, is the Nativity scene:

- Jesus in the manger (naked and poor in his humanity; asleep, but he will rise)
- Mother Mary with a ray of light “white as snow” (adorned with stars and crowned; veiled as the virgin bride) with hands in prayer, clearly plays the central role
- Saint Joseph with a candle (in the background as he is only the adopted father of Jesus; haloed for his sanctity; offering light as a service)
- The star of the Magi (God; light; guide) and
- The dark, cave-like background (the world in sin).

According to the current bishop of Higuey, the holy image is an icon, a book of symbols and colors, rich in wisdom, in which the Dominicans can read the truths of their faith.
