

(PRACTICING) CATHOLIC - RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

Step Into the Light

How strange it is to think that if not for Herod's directions, the magi would not have known where to find Jesus. They were not Jews, they knew nothing of the old prophecies. It was Herod who convened the scholars. It was Herod who pointed the way — for ulterior motives, certainly, but nonetheless, this is the part he played. It was Herod who made the Epiphany possible.

"Nations shall walk by your light, and kings by your shining radiance," writes the prophet (Isaiah 60:3). A king may keep to the shadows, suspicious of the light — he may foolishly imagine he can snatch it from the sky to keep as his own possession, and, upon finding the light cannot be governed, grow to loathe it, and even seek to extinguish it once and for all.

But all his grand designs will come to nothing because there is no king so powerful that he can see in the dark. And even a man like Herod — a man so jealous that he sought to kill God — cannot prevent the breaking of day.

The Epiphany marks the manifestation of Christ to the Gentiles. It is a celebration of truth reaching places it was not expected to reach, of brightness illuminating corners of the world long ago consigned to shadow. It is a reminder that the battle has already been won, the night is over. All that remains is for us to decide: will we step into the light?

"See, darkness covers the earth, and thick clouds cover the peoples; but upon you the LORD shines, and over you appears his glory." — Isaiah 60:2

¿POR QUÉ HACEMOS ESO? - VIDA CATÓLICA EXPLICADA

La Boda de Caná y la Epifanía

Pregunta:

¿Qué es la relación entre el bautismo del señor y el relato de las bodas de Cana, y la celebración de la Epifanía?

Respuesta:

El tiempo de la Epifanía centra en la relevación de Jesús al mundo. Tras la celebración de Navidad, el año litúrgico establece una serie de momentos de manifestación en que Jesús se da a conocer públicamente. Desde el principio la comunidad cristiana ha dado énfasis los tres eventos en la vida de Jesús. Esos son la Epifanía, el bautismo del Señor, y las bodas de Cana.

La Epifanía revela a Jesús al mundo de los gentiles, representados por los Magos de Oriente. Los relatos del bautismo de Jesús revelan su identidad y misión, y le expone a los que requieren el ministerio de Jesús. El milagro de convertir el agua al vino durante la boda de Cana, único en el Evangelio de Juan, es el primer acto público que Jesús realiza, y así, manifestando su identidad pública y poder.

Hoy en la Iglesia Romana, estos se celebran en tres domingos sucesivos: La Epifanía, el Bautismo del Señor que suele ser el domingo siguiente, y la fiesta de bodas de Caná, que se proclama el segundo domingo del tiempo ordinario en el año lectionario C.

Estas fiestas se conectan por el concepto de epifanía, la manifestación pública de Jesús al mundo. Nos ayudan a conocer más íntimamente quién es Jesús y de qué se trata. Dedique usted algún tiempo a profundizar más en su comprensión de quién es Jesús. Continúa cultivando estos momentos de "epifanía" en su vida.

SAINT OF THE WEEK – EXAMPLES OF OUR FAITH




St. Tarcisius

St. Tarcisius (263-275) was a 12-year-old boy who lived in 3rd-century Rome. Although much of what is known of him is from a poem written by Pope Damasus (366-384), he is considered an important martyr who protected the Eucharist from desecration with his life. He is the patron saint of altar servers and first communicants.

In 2010, at the end of a general audience dedicated to altar servers, Pope Benedict XVI blessed a 16-foot statue of Saint Tarcisius in St. Peter Square. The event was attended by some 50,000 altar servers from around the world. St. Tarcisius, pray for us!


