GOSPEL MEDITATION

If we do not wear the right pair of glasses, we can get all too easily caught up in the superficial stuff and neglect paying attention to the things that really matter. The kingdom of God is like the pearl of great price that is worth selling everything for so that it can be obtained. Based on where I invest my time and energy each day, I really wonder whether I am serving God's kingdom or my own. Have you ever considered tracking how you spend your time? You may be surprised! We allow our agendas to set the clock of our lives. We forget that joy and a true sense of purpose are not going to be found in following that timepiece. Joy is the expression of the happiness that is discovered when living in the kingdom of God. When our agenda matches God, not only do we leap for joy but God leaps with delight as well. Our well-being is what matters most to God.

Can you imagine God delighting in you? It is easy to deaden our senses to the whole reality of God and the joy that living the Gospel can bring. The demands of secular life and the agendas competing for our attention can quickly do that. We can get tired and spiritually apathetic. But if we can see our way through all of the conflicting voices and hear the voice of God, we can rediscover our zeal and passion and redirect our efforts. When we begin to see as God sees, we can rise each day and notice what really needs our attention and embrace it with exuberance. Be careful, though. It may not be what we originally had on our list. Responding to it, however, will be worth putting everything else aside.

MEDITACION DEL EVANGELIO
17º Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

El Evangelio nos sigue narrando parábolas sobre el Reino de Dios y de cómo actuar en él. El domingo pasado era sobre el trigo y la cizaña. Hoy la Liturgia nos presenta, el tesoro, la perla y la red. Encontrar el tesoro de la verdad y la justicia en nuestro tiempo es un trabajo de proceso que requiere un compromiso con Dios, la familia, la comunidad y con la persona misma. Las parábolas son una catequesis que indican la forma para salir y encontrar lo que se busca. "El Reino de los Cielos es como un tesoro escondido en un campo. El hombre que lo descubre, lo vuelve a esconder: su alegría es tal, que va, vende todo lo que tiene y compra ese campo". Y el Señor continúa narrando. "Un comerciante que busca perlas finas. Si llega a sus manos una perla de gran valor, se va, vende cuanto tiene y la compra". Y ahora, la de los peces. "Una red que se ha echado al mar y que recoge peces de todas clases. Cuando está llena, los pescadores la sacan a la orilla, se sientan, escogen los peces buenos, los echan en canastos y tiran los que no sirven". (Mateo 13:44-48).

Pidamos al Señor, en esta Eucaristía que nos dé la sabiduría de Salomón para encontrar los tesoros que nos lleven a vivir como hermanos y hermanas en estos tiempos de crisis que se están viviendo en diferentes lugares del mundo. Recordemos, que, el mejor tesoro es la amistad con Dios y quien la tiene, lo tiene todo. Salomón y San Pablo en las lecturas de hoy lo confirman.

USCIS is not accepting requests from individuals who have never before been granted deferred action under DACA. Until further notice, and unless otherwise provided in this guidance, the DACA policy will be operated on the terms in place before it was rescinded on Sept. 5, 2017.

World Day against Trafficking of Persons July 30, 2020

The World Day against Trafficking of Persons, proclaimed in 2013 by the UN General Assembly to be observed on July 30th each year, has as its purpose to raise awareness about human trafficking, the plight of its victims, and the protection of their rights. "Trafficking in persons is a vile crime that feeds on inequalities, instability, and conflict. Human traffickers profit from people's hopes and despair. They prey on the vulnerable and rob them of their fundamental rights." (UN General Secretary Antonio Guterres.) It is a crime that exploits women, children and men for numerous purposes, including forced labor and sex, which occurs across the globe and in our own communities.
