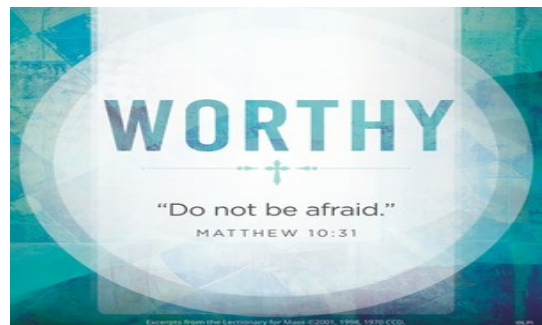
Will You Say Yes?

You find yourself in the difficult situation of being accused of blasphemy and confronting possible execution. Your crime is believing in Jesus Christ. The question is then asked of you, "Are you a Christian, a follower of the one named Jesus Christ?" Your answer may very well dictate what happens to you next. What is your answer?

It is probably easier to answer this question when the scenario is make-believe. All of us want to believe that we would say yes to the question of belief in Jesus, but strange things happen when humans panic in the face of extreme stress. As we reflect on what we would say, there are those all over the world who are being asked that very same question. It is a question that was asked of many in the first centuries of the Church. Those who respond "yes" are considered martyrs and saints.

We might not usually think of all this in terms of good stewardship living. However, our faith is also a gift we have received from God to cultivate, grow, and share with others. The more interesting question than the one posed above is, "Would an accuser even think of asking you such a question?" Would you have cultivated, grown, and shared your faith enough that anyone would even consider you worthy of asking the question? They might assume you don't know Jesus Christ at all. I don't like conflict and do not seek out conflict, but I would rather someone ask the first question posed than assume there is no reason to confront me in the first place.

2020 ORDINATION MASS

The 2020 Ordination Mass will take place at the Cathedral of Saint Joseph on **Saturday, June 27, beginning at 11:00 AM.** During this ceremony Rev. Mr. Jaime Maldonado-Aviles will be ordained to the Priesthood, and Matthew Collins and Joseph MacNeill will be ordained to the Diaconate. Due to current restrictions, this event will be by invitation only, and the select clergy, family, and friends who will be able to attend on that day have been invited.

While attendance at the Mass will be limited, the Ordination will be streamed live at 2020ordination.com, and all are most welcome to watch.

On Wednesday July 8 at 7:00 PM the Office for Catholic Social Justice Ministry of the Archdiocese of Hartford will continue their virtual conference series with a 60 minute webinar **"Racism without Racists"**.

The presenter is Christopher Doucot, founder of the Hartford Catholic Worker Community, Adjunct instructor of Sociology in several local universities, where he has taught race, class, nonviolence, and the author of "No Innocent Bystanders". This presentation will include the origins of race in colonial America and its current day consequences, explain how racism is more than individual acts motivated by prejudice, and suggest concrete steps toward achieving racial justice.

MEDITACIÓN DEL EVANGELIO

12º Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

No tengan miedo, dice Jesús tres veces en este Evangelio a sus apóstoles. A pesar de tanta dificultad y malos entendidos, el miedo debe dejarse a un lado y perseverar siempre, tratar de mantener la calma y la paz. Porque dice Jesús. “¿Acaso un par de pajaritos no se venden por unos centavos? Pero ni uno de ellos cae en tierra sin que lo permita vuestro Padre. En cuanto a ustedes, hasta sus cabellos están contados. ¿No valen ustedes más que muchos pajaritos? Por lo tanto, no tengan miedo”. (Mateo 10:29-31). Jesús va delante de nosotros, solo nos invita a confiar en el amor incondicional de Dios. Él fue fiel al Padre hasta la muerte y lo sabemos muy bien.

Y al que me niegue ante los hombres, yo también lo negaré ante mi Padre que está en los cielos”. (Mateo 10:32-33). Esta es la garantía para la vida presente y futura de todo cristiano. Siempre hacer el bien sin mirar a quien, como dice este dicho popular. De esta manera Jesús no nos desconocerá en el cielo.
