

WHAT IS THE HUMERAL VEIL?

One of the more exotic and misunderstood vestments is the humeral veil, the swath of fabric with which the priest is holding the monstrance. So why does he use it? It is to separate himself from the act of blessing. The priest or deacon blesses the faithful with the Blessed Sacrament — but by wrapping his hands in the humeral veil, he signifies his own removal from the action. The priest doesn't bless the people. *Christ* does.
