## An Announcement Regarding the Celebration of Mass in the Archdiocese of Hartford

In light of what the CDC has issued on March 15th regarding the cancellation or postponement of large events and mass gatherings of more than 50 people, and given the March 16th mandate of Governor Ned Lamont requiring the closure of all restaurants, bars, gyms and movie theaters, the Archdiocese of Hartford has cancelled all weekend and weekday Masses, effective Tuesday, March 17, 2020, in the churches of the Archdiocese (the counties of Hartford, Litchfield, and New Haven) through April 3, 2020. Priests will celebrate a daily Mass alone with no congregation, remembering in prayer all who are affected by the pandemic. Parishes will be encouraged to make provision for their churches to be open at some time so that individuals can still come and pray. Further direction and updates from the Archdiocese will be provided in a timely manner regarding Holy Week and all celebrations beyond that date.

Additionally, in response to the March 15th mandate of Governor Lamont requiring the closure of all Connecticut schools through at least March 31st, all Archdiocesan high schools and parochial schools will also be closed through March 31st.

### UN ANUNCIO SOBRE LA CELEBRACIÓN DE LA MISA EN LA ARQUIDIÓCESIS DE HARTFORD

A la luz de lo que emitieron los CDC el 15 de marzo con respecto a la cancelación o aplazamiento de grandes eventos y reuniones masivas de más de 50 personas, y dado el mandato del 16 de marzo del gobernador Ned Lamont que requiere el cierre de todos los restaurantes, bares, gimnasios y películas en los cines, la Arquidiócesis de Hartford ha cancelado todas las misas de fin de semana y días laborables, a partir del martes 17 de marzo de 2020, en las iglesias de la Arquidiócesis (los condados de Hartford, Litchfield y New Haven) hasta el 3 de abril de 2020. Los sacerdotes celebrarán un Misa diaria sola sin congregación, recordando en oración a todos los afectados por la pandemia. Se animará a las parroquias a hacer provisiones para que sus iglesias estén abiertas en algún momento para que las personas puedan venir a rezar. Se proporcionarán más instrucciones y actualizaciones de la Arquidiócesis de manera oportuna con respecto a la Semana Santa y todas las celebraciones más allá de esa fecha.

Además, en respuesta al mandato del 15 de marzo del Gobernador Lamont que requiere el cierre de todas las escuelas de Connecticut hasta al menos el 31 de marzo, todas las escuelas secundarias arquidiocesanas y las escuelas parroquiales también estarán cerradas hasta el 31 de marzo.

### 4º DOMINGO DE LA CUARESMA

Supo Jesús que lo habían echado fuera, y cuando lo encontró, le dijo: "¿Crees tú en el Hijo del hombre?"  
- Jn 9, 35

“Do you believe in the Son of Man?” Jesus wants to motivate each one of us to see the truth. After developing a relationship with Jesus, the blind man “sees” as someone very special. The Pharisees, due to the blindness caused by their ignorance, prejudice, and need for self-preservation, still remain blind. Presuppositions, prejudices, assumptions, and our needs can easily blind us to truth. We see what we want or need to see and not what is really there. In addition, our stubbornness continues to convince us that we are right and that our vision is perfect. Only God can complete the picture.

Look around at our world. So much of what is happening today is due to the reluctance of folks to allow themselves to be stretched and brought to see what is really there. Many react to what life presents to them more with the lenses of ignorance than lenses of clarity. The Gospel carries great transformative value. With it, God corrects our vision and replaces our limited sight with the fullness of his sight. God opens our eyes so that we can see that it is not about preserving what we have created but of living in the immensity and wonder of God’s kingdom.

Through a simple, loving relationship with God, we can break through the tethers of prejudice, eradicate fear, dispel the darkness of hatred and sin, discover freedom, live in peace, work for justice, be effective stewards of creation, assist the migrant and the immigrant, and safeguard our economic systems and policies so that they truly serve all of God’s children. What we see is often an artificial lie. Our truth is much bigger than what our limited sight believes it to be. Allow God to work in and through you. Do not be afraid. Be open and be humble enough to know that you need help. Many human beings are living with severe cataracts that produce sight that is at best blurred. Are you one of them?
