Follow the hacks!

Hack 1: Share & Downsize

- Go halves on essentials If travelling with someone, split bulky items like face wash, moisturiser, and body lotion to save space.
- Travel-size everything Opt for minis or decant into 100ml bottles for carry-on (stay within the liquid limit!).

Hack 2: Organised Carry-On

- Liquids ready to go Store all 100ml liquids in a clear, resealable bag to breeze through security.
- Electronics on top Keep your phone, chargers, and headphones easily accessible. Pack hair tools first if needed for quick inspection.
- Bumbag trick Keep passport, phone, and cards in a waist pack.
 Slip into your handbag to meet the two-bag limit while keeping essentials at hand.

Hack 3: Pack Like a Pro

- Suitcase strategy Shoes at the bottom (in shoe bags), clothes rolled or folded for space-saving.
- Compartment bags Separate toiletries, chargers, and small bits into pouches for easy access.
- Solid soaps = no liquid hassle Swap body wash for a soap bar to save space and avoid leaks.

Hack 4: Keep It Simple

• Top-down packing – Keep inflight essentials (snacks, book, headset, water bottle) at the top of your carry-on for easy access
