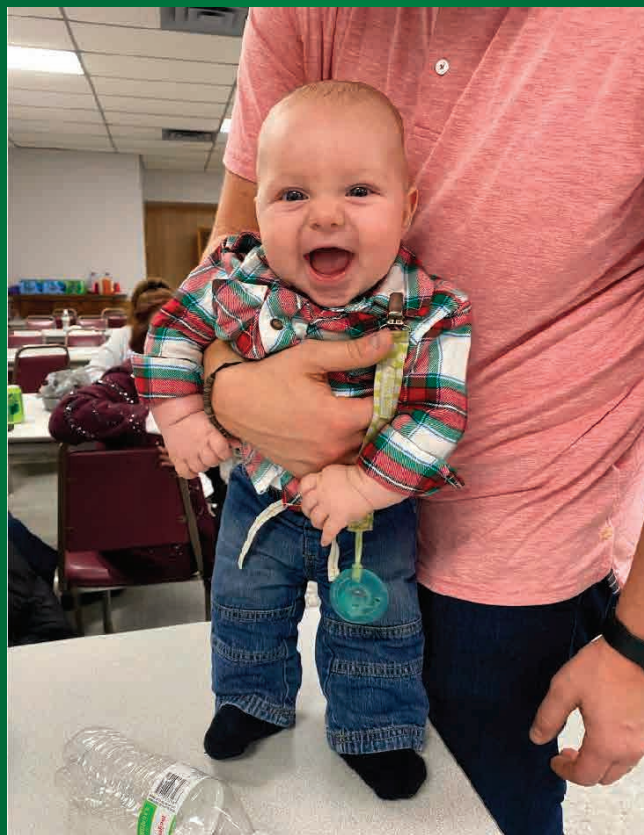
Pancakes & Sausage!
