Applicant must be an Ohio resident. Applicant must be a current youth policy member of a fraternal society, or included in a family member policy that does not have youth policies belonging to the Ohio Fraternal Alliance, and be in good standing.

- 1. Applicant must be a 2025 high school graduate attending an accredited college, university, trade or technical school, or school of nursing as a full-time student in the Fall.
- 2. Applicant must submit a minimum 150-word essay entitled: How I have been personally involved in my Fraternal Society and how I plan to be involved in the Future.
- 3. Applicant must submit a separate list for each of the following categories:
- a.) Church related activities,
- b.) Local community and volunteer activities,
- c.) School activities/clubs.
- 4. Applicant must submit a letter of recommendation from your local Fraternal Society officer explaining your involvement in your Fraternal Society.
- 5. Essay, all activities, and letter will be judged. Completed application must be dated and submitted by April 1, 2025, and sent to:
