When their daughter was discharged from the hospital, they were able to pick out a special toy for her in celebration of going home as well. All of the toys were available to the family at no cost. The toys that fill the Toy Closet are all donated by groups and individuals.

CLC wants to fill the Toy Closet for Christmas so other families, like the Spring family, have the ability to bring Christmas joy to their children too. We need your help!
