Eligibility Requirements for \$1,000 Scholarship

- 1. Applicant must be planning to enroll as a full-time (minimum 12 credit hours) student at any university or college, with the intention of completing an undergraduate, graduate, associate degree or professional requirement.
- 2. Must provide volunteer activities participated in for the previous year.
- 3. Applicant must currently have a life insurance policy with CLC, and must have held that policy for at least three years as of **February 29, 2024.**
- 4. Recipients are required to use their award in the school year for which they apply.
- 5. Members may apply for a CLC scholarship repeatedly, but they may only win two scholarships.

- 1. Two letters of recommendation from an academic source, such as a teacher, your high school principal, guidance counselor, or college instructor sharing with us particular examples why your qualifications merit one of our scholarships to be awarded to you.
- 2. Most recent transcript, including GPA, of your high school or college grades and/or any other school you have attended. Applicant may also include standardized test scores (ACT, SAT, etc.).
- 3. A 500-1000 word essay telling us about yourself, your interests, work experiences, organizations in which you belong, community involvement/activities, personal achievements, the reason you have chosen your field of study and why you feel you are particularly qualified for a CLC scholarship.
- 4. A recent photo, wallet size is preferable.
- 5. Complete the "Volunteer Hours" form included with this application.

All materials must be postmarked by February 29, 2024 for your application to be considered. Scholarship applications will be judged on the basis of the information that is provided. Judges' decisions are final. Members will be furnished a copy of the scholarship guidelines upon request.
