**Follow the B1010 (Burnham Road) heading towards Burnham-on-Crouch.
Stay on the B1010 for approximately 3½ miles around the “Burnham Bends”**

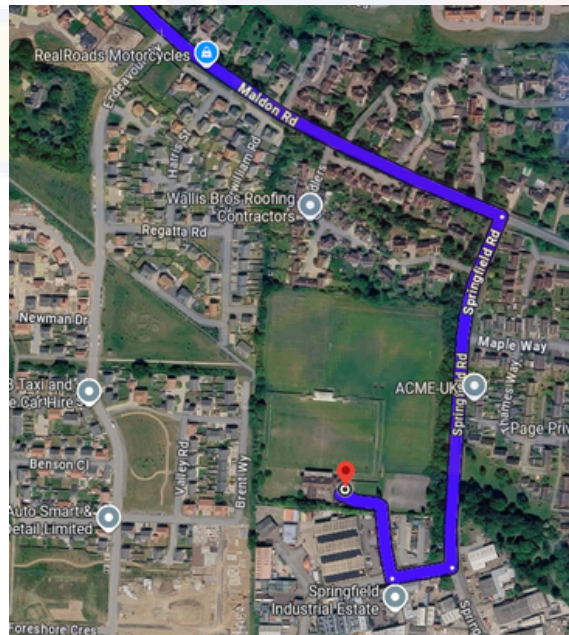
As you enter Burnham-on-Crouch, continue along Maldon Road

Turn right into Springfield Road.

Continue along Springfield Road for about 200 metres.

Take the second right before Springfield Autocare, then immediately first right into the club entrance.

The clubhouse and parking are directly ahead at Leslie Field

There are toilets within the clubhouse



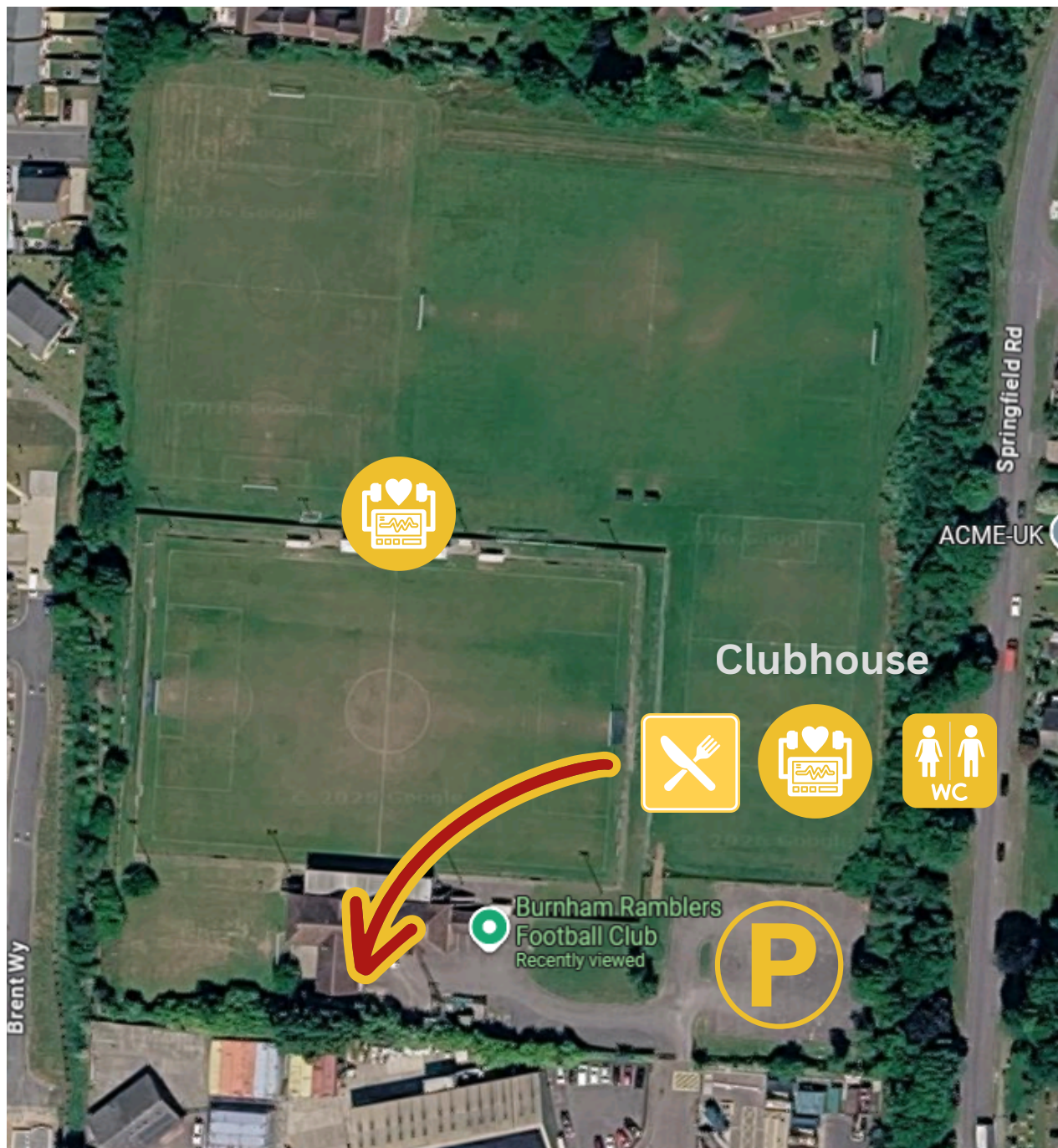
Clubhouse/ Refreshments

Pitch Information at Burnham Ramblers FC

Stadium Pitch:

Access is via the main turnstiles/player entrance.

Back Pitches:

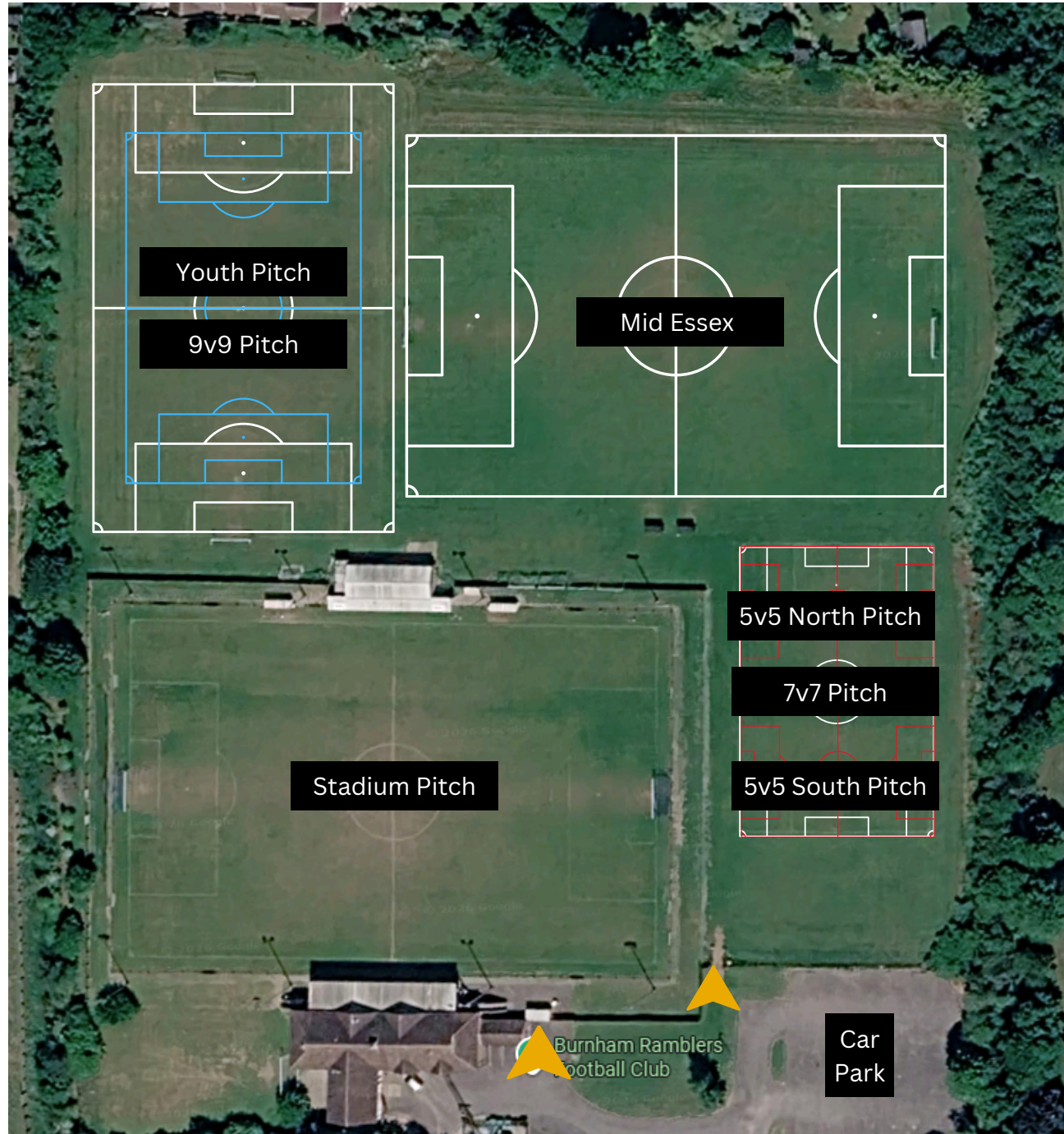
Access is through the gate located at the side of the stadium from the car park.

9v9 Pitch:

The 9v9 pitch is marked within the Youth Pitch, located around the far side of the stadium.

7v7 & 5v5 Pitches:

The 7v7 pitch is the first pitch you come to after entering through the gates, with the two 5v5 pitches marked within this area.



How to find Burnham Primary School

**Follow the B1010 (Burnham Road) heading towards Burnham-on-Crouch.
Stay on the B1010 for approximately 3½ miles around the “Burnham Bends”**

As you enter Burnham-on-Crouch, continue straight towards the town.

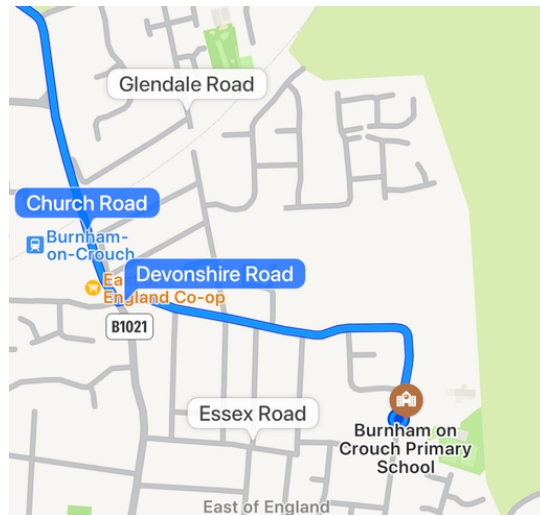
Turn right into Church Road, continue along and over the bridge, take the second right into Devonshire Road, follow this round into Arcadia Road/ Dunkirk Road and the School is signposted on your left hand side.
