We here at Living the Doxie Dream Rescue really love our dogs! They are all at our sanctuary while we wait for their perfect home. This gives us the time to fully assess each dog and find a forever home that meets their specific needs.

Because we take dog ownership so seriously, we are a bit picky about where our dogs go! We do not want to waste your time, so please read the following requirements, and make sure you would qualify before responding. We want the placement to be a good fit for the dog and for you!

DO YOU HAVE A FENCED YARD?

We require a secure fenced yard for most of our dogs. Our dogs are all enjoying this amenity in their foster homes. We want our dogs to continue to have this in their future home. Most of our dogs cannot be in a home with chain link fencing, because many dogs can climb this type of fence. Wrought iron fencing might need to have wire mesh added. Dog parks do not satisfy this requirement, and we are not fans of them for safety reasons. The rescue has no issues with apartment dwellers. But I have concern of open balconies on 2nd and 3rd floors but can be up for review.
