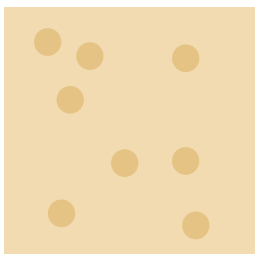
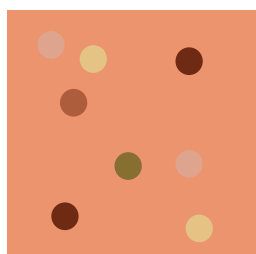
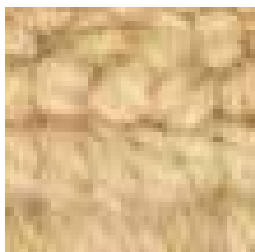
Other Materials

- Tapestry needle
 - hand-sewing needle
- Steel Big-Eye Needle
 - for whip stitching with bulky yarn
- Masking Tape

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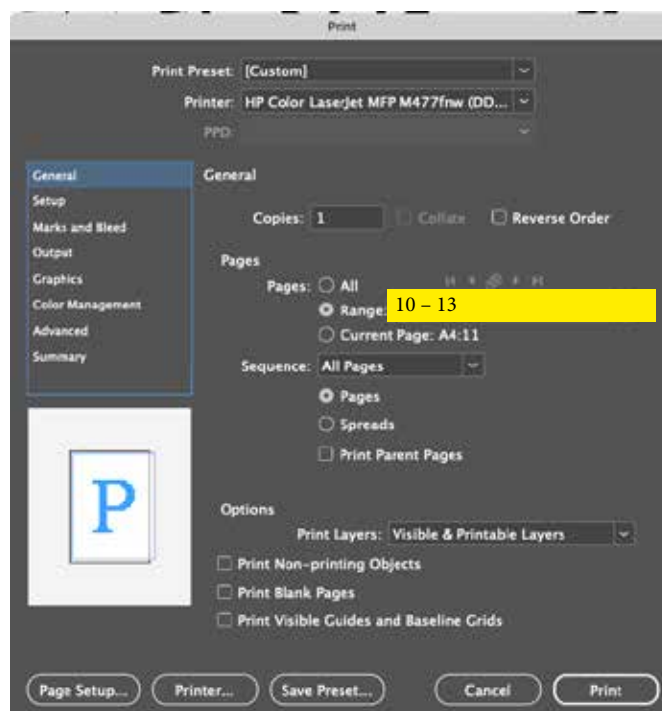
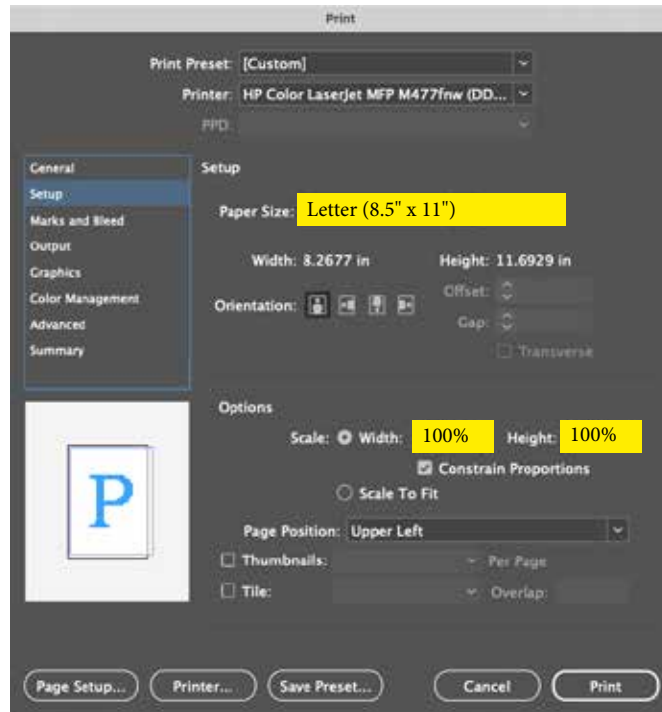

Printing Instructions

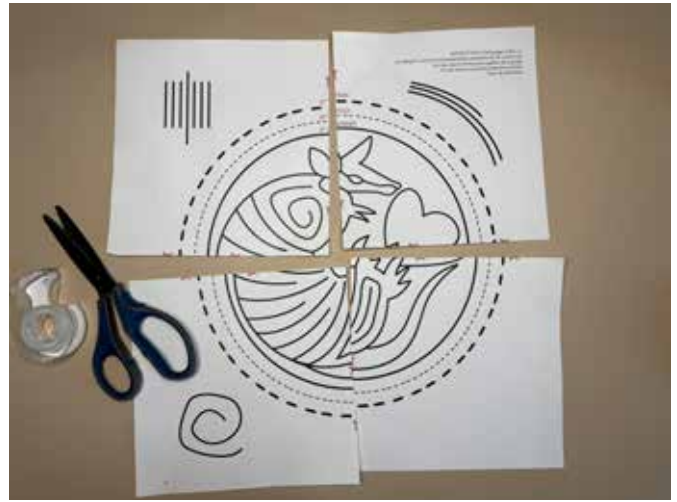
Print your pattern in either black and white or color onto letter-size paper at 100% scale.



Assembly Instructions



Cut the dotted lines marked with the scissor icons. If you printed in color, these are dotted pink lines.



Then orient your pattern from top left going clockwise. Page 10, 11, 12, 13.

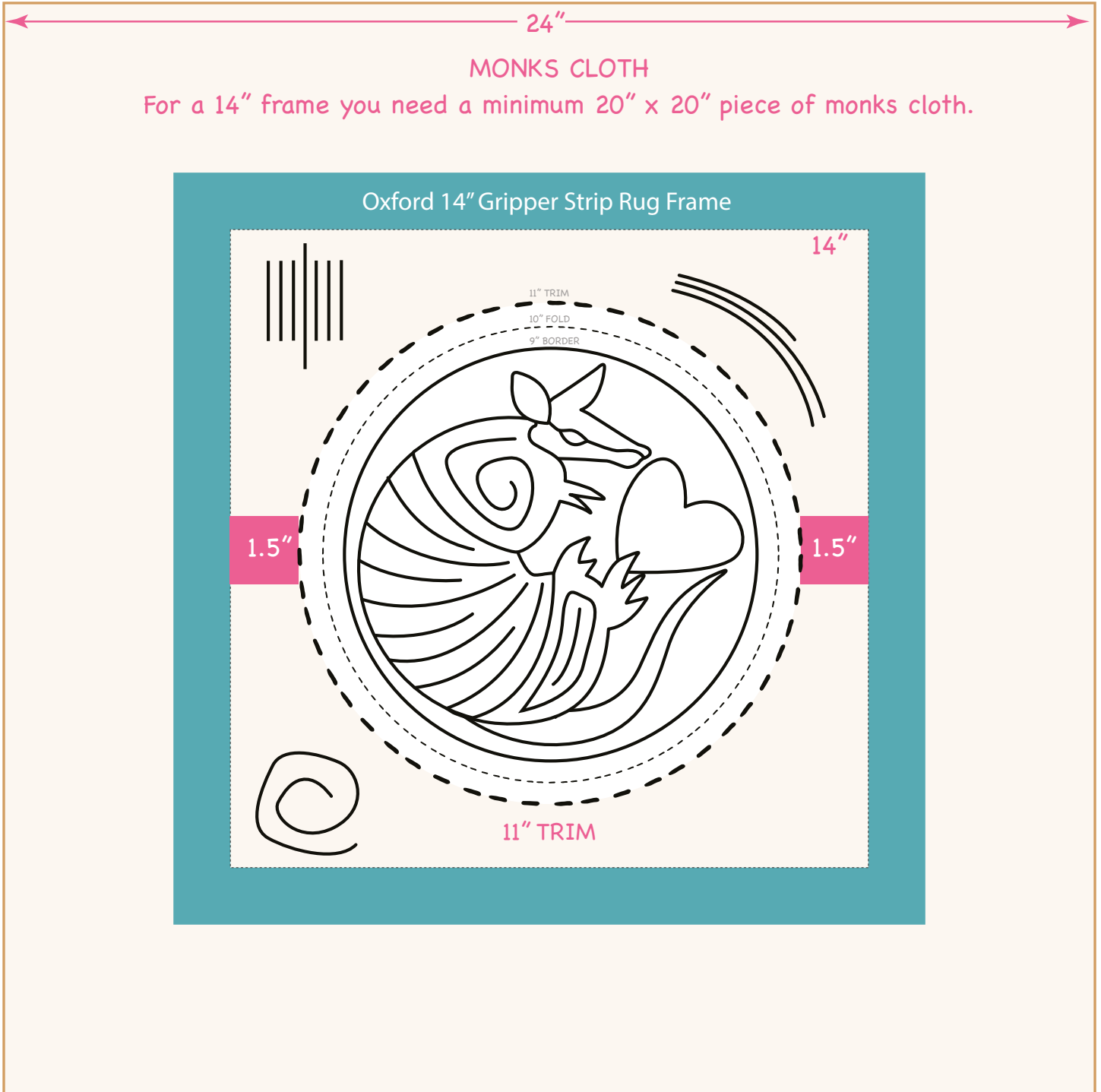


Use small pieces of clear tape to put your pattern together. Avoid using large pieces of tape until your pattern is lined up correctly.



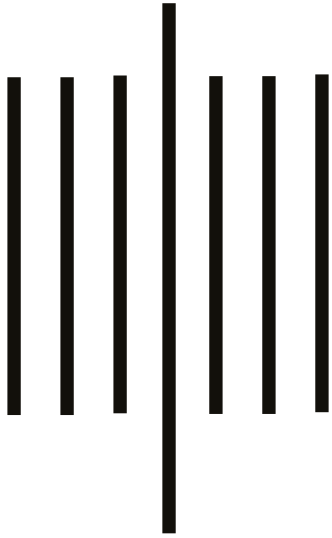
Double check that you printed it at 100% by making measuring your pattern with a ruler.

Placement for 18" Frame

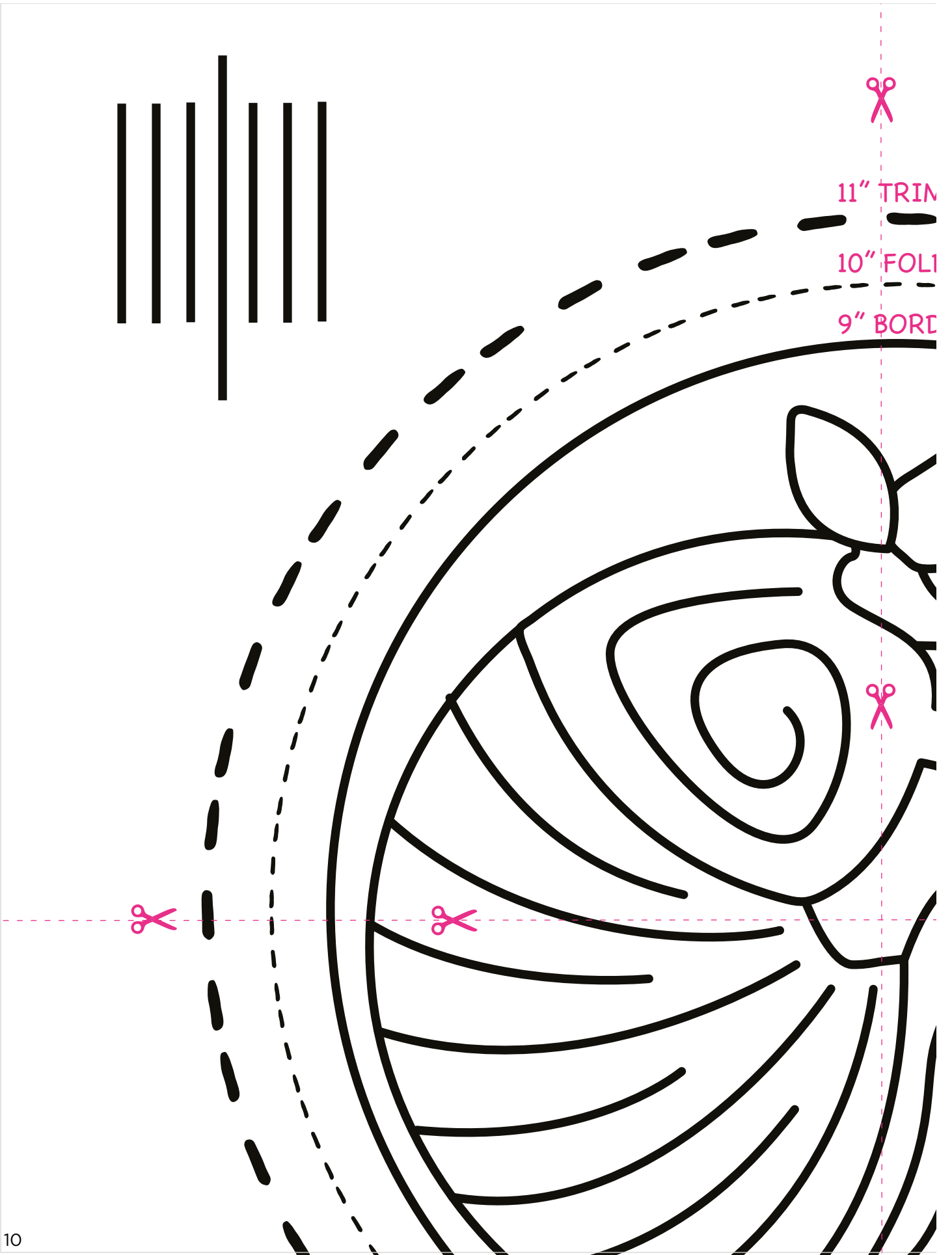

9" BORI

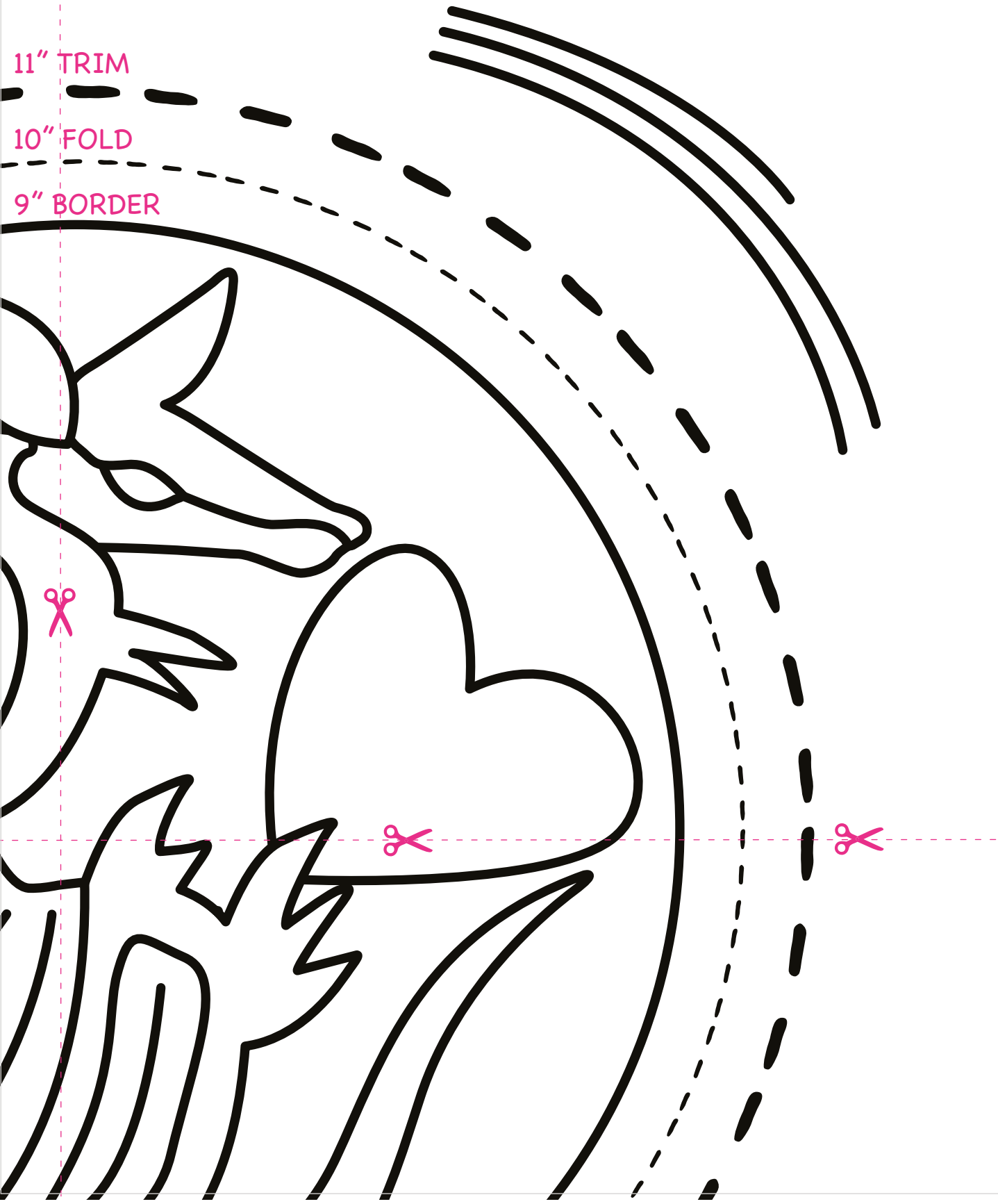


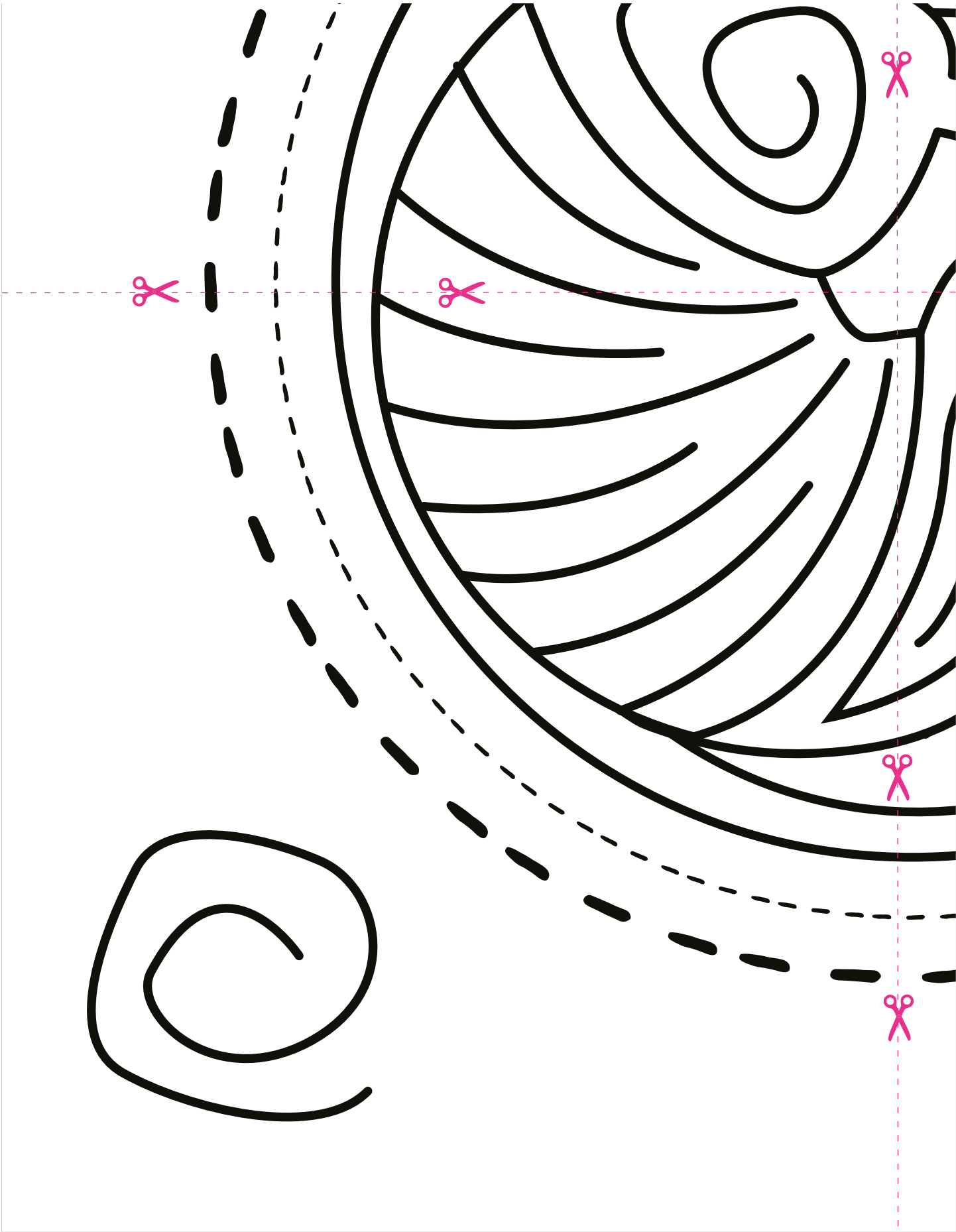


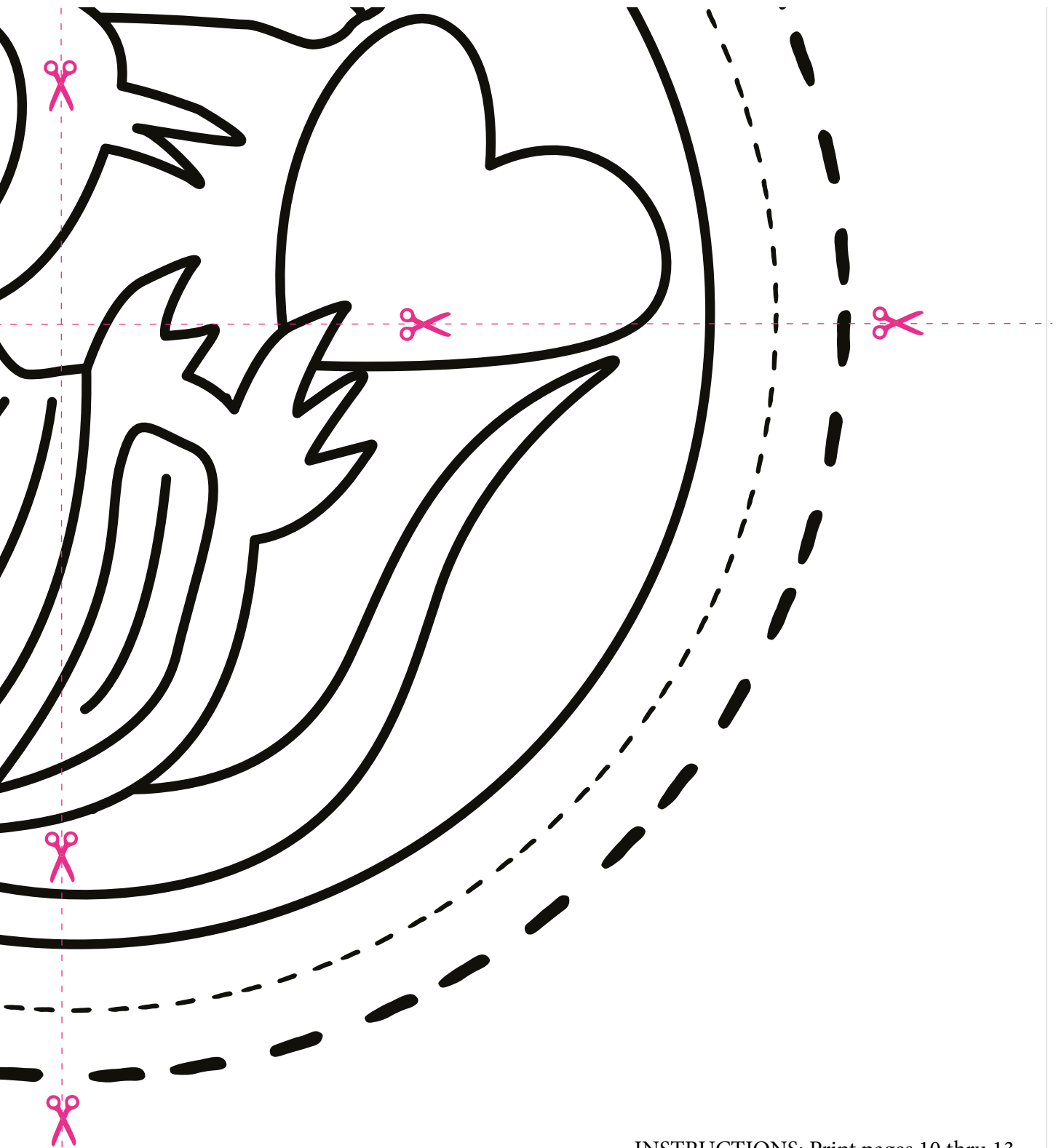

INSTRUCTIONS: Print pages 10 thru 13.
Cut along the vertical and horizontal lines indicated with the scissor icon.
Use clear tape to fit the pieces together like a puzzle.
You do not have to trace the pink lines and text.
Trace the black lines.
