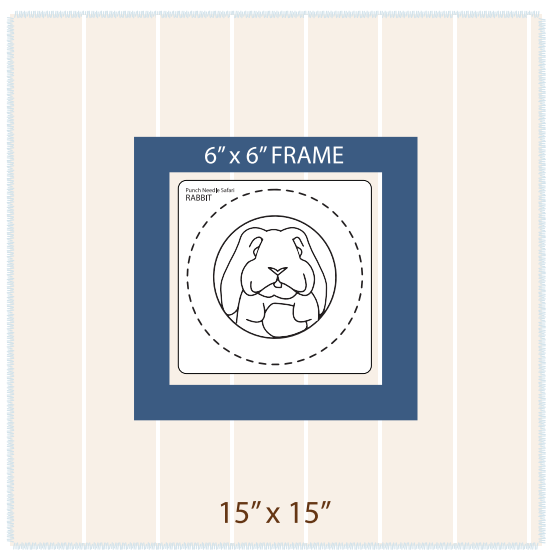

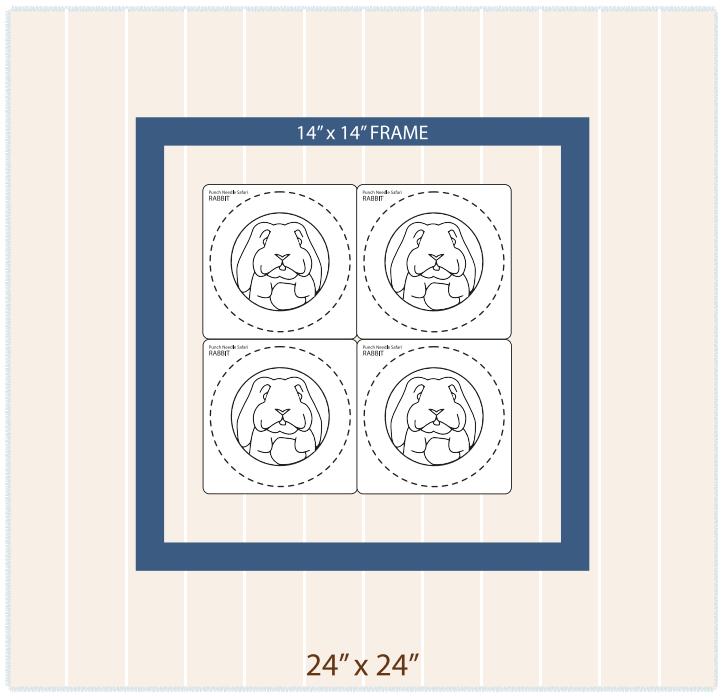
## RABBIT

Punch Needle Safari

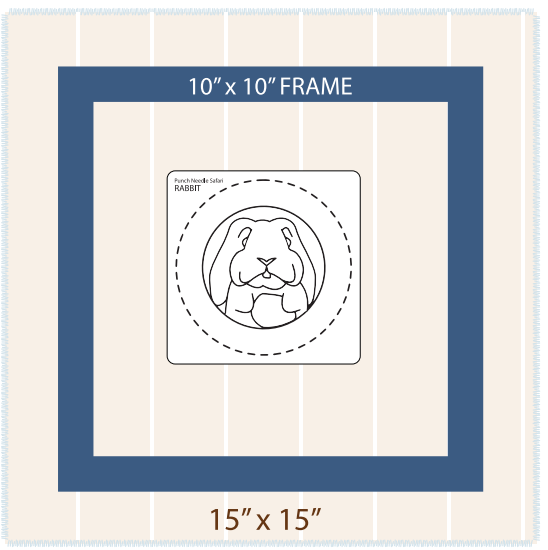

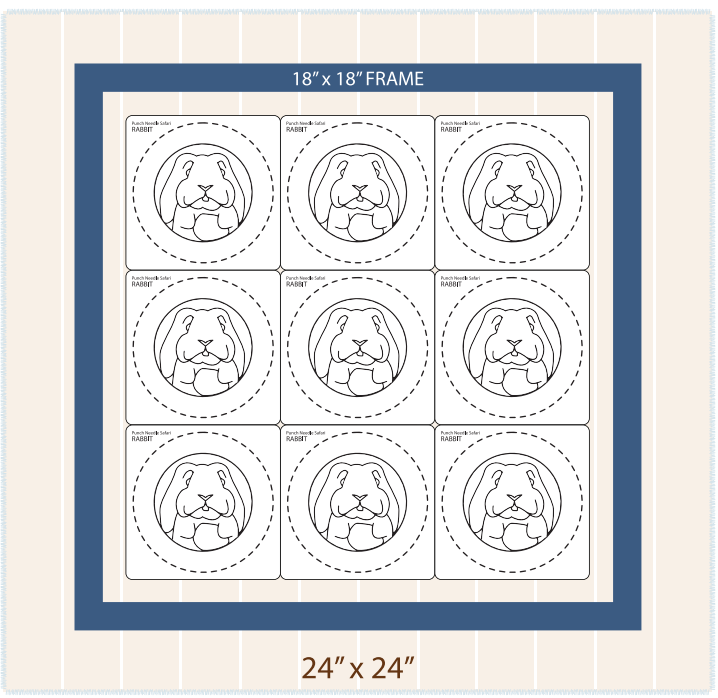
The illustration above shows how a 15" x 15" monk's cloth will fit on a 6" x 6" Oxford Gripper Strip Frame.



If you have a larger frame you can make more than one Rabbit using the stencil. For multiples you may need to buy extra yarn.



The illustration above shows how a 15" x 15" monk's cloth will fit on a 10" x 10" Oxford Gripper Strip Frame.



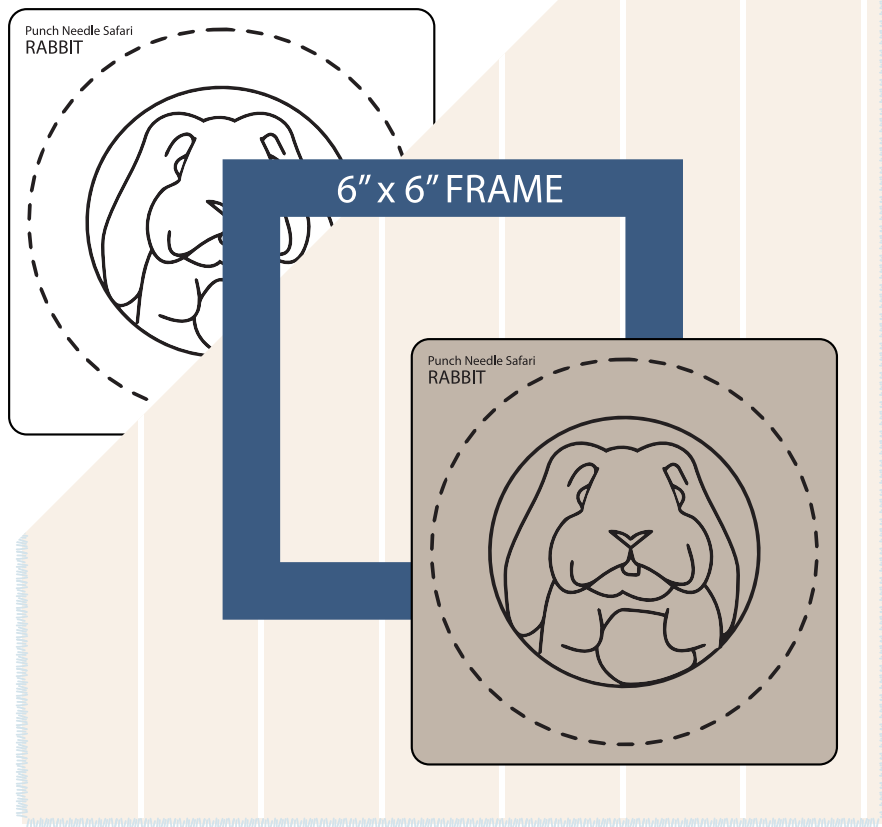

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Trace with EITHER the printed pattern or the stencil pattern.

use either **Printed Pattern**

Trace the printed pattern using a window or light box by placing it face-down on the bottom side of your framed monk's cloth.



or... **Stencil Pattern**

Trace the stencil face-up on top of your stretched monk's cloth. Then connect the dots to make the lines match the printed pattern.
