- Please come visit, sign-in at the Virtual Receptionist, and enjoy some much needed mindfullness in nature at Masonville Cove.









## Education-Spring 2020

- Traditional outreach programs and fieldtrips have also been directly impacted by the pandemic.
- Living Classrooms Foundation Masonville Cove education staff made and distributed 800 STEAM to-go boxes for students at our local schools.
- Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, and Math (each box contained 5 hands-on activities and supplies for students to complete at home).









### Education-Summer 2020

- BEESMART (Baltimore Environmental Education Summer Math and Reading Trailblazers) ran 5 weeks of Virtual E-STEM programming for 50 students from Maree G Farring and Lakeland Elementary Schools. This program prevents summer learning loss.
- Masonville Cove Summer Science and Nature Program starts on Monday. Each registered child (\$50) receives a Discovery Backpack Kit which contains 10 hands-on science and 5 craft activities, and log-in information for daily 1hr Virtual LIVE Google Classrooms sessions.
