The Doyle's know the ditch is good and the water is not running on their property. Update Furnace and Maintenance: The furnace filter have been changed, they are up inside and are hard to find. Will put a note by furnace to let people know where they are located. Sprinkler system will be taken care of tomorrow. Water softener also taken care of.

<u>Pickup:</u> Bumper has been fixed. The support for the transmission is rusting out and needs to be fixed. We will take it to the most reasonable place to have it fixed.
